**WEEKEND CRIME REPORT
16 AUGUST 2015**

KHOMAS REGION

Murder

On 16/08/2015 at about 09:00, on the Daan Viljoen main Road, a 19-years-old Namibian male succumbed to his injuries on the way to a hospital after he was cut open in the stomach. It is alleged that the deceased and the suspect had a quarrel during the evening on the 15/08/2015, whereby the suspect allegedly cut open the deceased. The incident occurred at Farm Karanab, Daan Viljoen area. The suspect is a 28-years-old male and not yet arrested. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

Groot Aub –Murder

On the 15/08/2015 between 02:00 and 03:00, at Groot Aub, a 42-years-old Namibian male died on the spot after he was stabbed several times on the body, while a passenger was stabbed once, by three suspects aged 17,20 and 22 years old respectively. It is alleged that the deceased was in the truck at the time of the incident, while the passenger was outside of the truck when they were attacked by the suspects. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Suspects will appear on 17/08/2015 in Court.

Wanaheda- Armed Robbery

On 15/08/2015 at about 02:00 at Okurangava, a 24-years-old male was allegedly robbed off his motor vehicle, a cellphone, a jacket and cash of N\$30-00 by unknown suspect(s). The vehicle was recovered. No suspect arrested yet. Police investigations continue.

OSHIKOTO REGION

Omuthiya- Culpable Homicide

On 15/08/2015 at about 19:00 on the Oshivelo/ Omuthiya main Road, near Omutsogonime Village, two passengers aged 7 and 32 years old died on the spot, while the drivers of both vehicles and a passenger sustained serious injuries. It is alleged that the motor vehicle they were travelling in allegedly bumped a donkey, causing the driver to lose control of the motor vehicle. The injured victims were taken to Oshakati State Hospital. The next of kin of the deceased are informed. Police investigations continue.

Okatope- Inquest

On 15/08/2015 at about 04:00 at Omutse Village, Onyaanya area, a 3 months old baby boy died in the room where he was asleep with the mother. It is alleged that the mother only notice that the baby was dead during morning time. The cause of death is unknown. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

KAVANGO EAST

Rundu- Culpable Homicide

On 15/08/2015 at about 23:30 at Kayirayira Village, on the outskirts of Rundu, a 27-years-old male sustained serious injuries. It is alleged that he was bumped by the drive of a White Midge Mazada. It is further alleged that the victim had a argument with the driver, before the driver drove off reckless before bumping the victim. The victim was admitted at the Rundu State Hospital, in a critical condition. The suspect is known but not yet arrested. Police investigations continue.

OMUSATI REGION

Okahao- Inquest

On 16/08/2015 at about 07:00 at Ondeka Village, Ogongo Constituency, an 8 months old baby boy died in a hut. It is alleged that the deceased was in the room with a 3-years-old toddle girl in the room when the incident occurred. The toddle escaped unhurt. The cause of the blaze is unknown. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

ZAMBEZI REGION

Katima Mulilo-Inquest

On 14/08/2015 at about 00:15 on the Ngoma/Katima Mulilo main road near Mile 17, a 29-years-old Namibian male died on the spot, while a passenger sustained injuries. It is alleged that the driver (unlicensed) of a Toyota Corolla lost control over the vehicle,

causing the vehicle to overturn. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

Katima Mulilo-Inquest

On 16/08/2015 at about an unknown time, the body of a 33- years-old Zambian male was found after the canoe he and others were being transported capsized on the 12/08/2015 at about 18:00 in the Zambezi River at Kalimbeza area. It is alleged that the canoe was transporting people from Namibia across the river to Zambia when the canoe suddenly capsized and sank. It is further alleged that the other canoe occupants including the pilot managed to swim to the bank of the river. The next of kin of the deceased is not yet informed. Police investigations continue.

Katima Mulilo -Reckless and or negligent driving

On 14/08/2015 at about 18:57 along the Trans Caprivi High way near Engen Service Station, Katima Mulilo town, a 17- years- old female sustained seriously head injuries after she was allegedly hit by a white Toyota Venture. It is alleged that the victim was running trying to cross the road at the time of the incident. The victim was transferred Otjiwarongo State Hospital. She is reported to be in a stable condition. Police investigations continue.

Katima Mulilo-Inquest

On 2015/08/16 at about 01:00 at Lusu village, Masokotwane area, a body of 55- years-old Namibian male has been found on the bed in his room. It is alleged that the deceased arrived early home and went to bed but later that night he was discovered dead on his bed. The cause of the death is not yet known. The deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

Katima Mulilo-Inquest

On 16/08/2015 at about 02:30 at New Cow Boy location, Katima Mulilo, a 30-years-old Namibian female and a Namibian male (age not give) died in the room where they were sleeping. It is alleged that the room was burnt down, and the cause of the blaze is unknown. The female deceased's next of kin are informed. Police investigations continue.

Katima Mulilo- Housebreaking with Intent to Steal and Theft

On 11/08/2015 at an unknown time at Swapo Party Regional Headquarters- Bboma Location, Katima Mulilo, unknown suspect(s) gained entrance into the Swapo Party

Headquarters premises through a hole near the premises main gate and broke the window of the Regional Coordinator's office to gain entry and exit. The suspect(s) stole the following properties: 2 x Lenovo PC, 2 x Lenovo Key-boards, 2 x Lenovo mouse, 1 x Lenovo monitor and cash of N\$12 000. 00.

The values and serial numbers of these items are not yet known and such values and serial numbers are yet to be received from the complainants. It is alleged that the break was noticed by the cleaner at the Swapo Party Headquarters on Tuesday 11 August 2015 at about 08:00 in the morning. No recovery or arrests. Police investigations continue.

//KARAS REGION

Bethanie- Attempted Rape

On 14/08/2015 at about 23:00 at Schmellendorf Location, Bethanie, a 28-years-old Namibian male was arrested after he allegedly tried to rape a 63-years-old female. Police investigations continue.

Aroab- Possession of Drugs

On 12/08/2015 at about 13:45 at Aroab, a 24-years-old Namibian male was arrested after he found in possession of 819 grams of cannabis (valued at N\$2 430-00). The suspect was arrested during a Police Operations. Police investigations continue.
