CRIME REPORT

Omusati Region

Outapi: Suicide (Hanging)

On 4th January 2017 at unknown time, at Antanga village Elim Constituency.

It is reported that a Thimoteus Amunyela 69 male Namibian, hanged himself with a belt under a tree in the bush.

The deceased was last seen alive on 03/01/2017 during night time and it was discovered that he hanged himself on the 04/01/2017 at about 09:00.

No suicide note was left. The corpse was transported to Okahao Police Mortuary.

The next of kin were informed.

Police investigation continues.

Oshikuku Police Station (Rape)

On Tuesday, 03 January 2017 at about 21:00hrs, at Okafa Koisongo Village at Outapi Constituency.

It is reported that suspect had sexual intercourse without any consent with a victim who is a minor 15yrs Female Namibian. It is further reported that the suspect is a step father to the victim.

No arrest was made at time reported.

Police investigation continues.

Outapi: Drowning

Between Wednesday 4th January and 5th January 2017 at unknown time, at Otamanzi in the Otamanzi Constituency. It is reported that Wilhelmina Pondjamba 68 female Namibian drowned in a Well. It is reported that the deceased went to local cuca shops during the night and was found drowned at about 07:00am on the 5th January 2017 by family members.

The deceased body was taken to Okahao Police Mortuary for outopsy.

Kunene Region

Opuwo: Culpable homicide and driving without driver's license

It is alleged that on the 3rd January 2017, a driver of the vehicle with registration number **N 1214 OP** Toyota pick- up was travelling from Opuwo to Etanga on the way around ±30km to Etanga; he lost control of the vehicle and overturned.

There were 4 passengers in the vehicle, (3) passengers sustained serious injuries and one (1) died on the spot. Name of the deceased is Kavetutjiua Maundu 19 Namibian male.

Next of kin are already informed.

Omaheke: Epukiro: Robbery

It is reported that on the 05/01/2017 at around 23:00hrs at Ngaturande shop (Epukiro Post 10). It is alleged that 3 male suspects, Otjiherero speaking Namibian came to a bar lady while she was sleeping and knocked pretending to be sent by the business owner apparently to bring some materials for the business to her.

When she opened the door, one of the suspects put a knife to her neck demanding keys of the bar while the other suspect tied her legs with a rope. They opened the bar and pushed the complainant inside and put cello tape to her face.

The suspects broke the Jackpot and took it to their car, while they also tried to rape the lady which they couldn't succeed and drove off in a white caddy with unknown registration.

The value of the Jack pot is **\$85850-00**.

No arrest was made yet.

Oshana

Oshakati Police station, Drunken driving

It is reported that on the 7th January 2017, at about 02:00hrs a 30 year old driver of a vehicle with a registration number **N179356W** was arrested after being found operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol on the Oneshila main road.

Ongwediva: Rape

It was reported that on the 7th January 2017, at around 22:00, at Okatope water pan (behind united bar) a 17 years old from Eefa doukadona village, was raped by a suspect known to her, grabbed her arm and twisted it and beat her with fists before he took her clothes and had sexual intercourse without her consent. But the suspect was still at large at the time of reporting the incident to the Police.

And Police investigations continue.

Oshakati: Suicide (Inquest)

It is reported that on the 8th January, 2017, at around 07:00hrs, at Ondjodjo village Okatana area, Amukoto Nghiyoonanye Shilinge Konrad 30 yrs old Namibian male committed suicide/hanged himself in his bedroom, the deceased was very sick. No suicide note was left.

Police investigations continue.

//Karas Region (Rape)

It is reported that on the 08th January 2017 at unknown time, eastern camp an 18 year old was raped by a 21 year old Namibian male, the suspect who took her to her house and had sexual intercourse with her without her consent,

The suspect was arrested, and has already appeared at Noordoewer Magistrate Court.

Kavango East Region (Culpable Homicide)

It is reported that on Sunday the 08th January 2017 at around 21:25hrs at Mutjiku village near bush baby 5Km from Divundu check point on trans Kalahari high way, a 32 year old driver of red Toyota conquest registration number **N1082OT** was driving from Katima Mulilo to Windhoek, he hit a pedestrian who was crossing the road and the pedestrian died. The deceased's name is Namawe Immanuel, a 49 year old Namibian male, who is a Police Officer, a member of Special Field Force Directorate at bush baby post. It is suspected that the driver was under the influence of alcohol, although it could not be detected by the breathalyzer.

Next of kin are already informed.

Police investigations continue.

Okavango East: Rundu District (Rape)

It is reported that on Sunday 31 December 2016 at about 23:00hrs at Likwaterera Village Rundu District, a 53 years old Namibian female was raped by a 50 years old Namibian male. The suspect entered the victim's room while she was sleeping, pull off the blanket and had sexual intercourse with her without her consent. The suspect was arrested.

Police investigations continue.

Ongwediva: Armed Robbery

It is reported that on the 7th January at around 22:10hrs Antonio Mayungo an Angolan male 37 year old male was attacked by four (4) suspects armed with two (2) pistol in his house, at Erf 3945 Hanova, Ongwediva. The suspects robbed him a Lumina Cell phone valued at N\$ 2 500.00 and the complainant was beaten with pistols in the face and stabbed with knives on his back, he was not seriously injured but he is admitted in the hospital. The suspects are not known and no arrest has been made yet.

Police investigations continue.

Okahao (Inquest)

It is reported that on the 01st January 2017 at around 19:00hrs, a Namibian female 8 years old from Etilyasa Village Otamanzi Constituency, allegedly drowned in the water pond at their neighbor's fence yard.

It is also reported that on 01st January 2017 at around 19:00hrs, a Namibian male 1 year old from Etilyasa Village Otamanzi Constituency, allegedly drowned in the water pond whilst they

were their neighbor's fence yard. The deceased's were allegedly left in their neighbors care of Nabors by their guardian and sneaked from their nabours house with the intention of going home.

Next of kin's are already informed.

Okahandja Culpable Homicide

It is reported that on the 9th of January 2017, at around 19:00hrs 10 , on the Okahandja Karibib Road about 16 klm, a driver of a green Hyundai Elandra with a registration number **N82859W**, was driving from west to east lost control of the vehicle and bumped against the tree. The driver John Reinhardt Pesca 67 n/ male dead on the spot while two passengers who were in the vehicle both didn't sustain injuries.
