Serious Crime incidents reported across the country

KHOMAS REGION

KATUTURA POLICE STATION : INQUEST (HANGING)

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 13h20, in a riverbed at Lafrenz Industrial Area, 27 years old man was found hanging with a rope under a tree.

The deceased was identified as Julius Shitileni (N/Male, 27 years).

No suicide note was left. The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

WINDHOEK STATION : INQUEST (BURNING)

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 00h00, at Farm Satan Schloch, Khomas Hochland, 18 years old man burned to death after his sleeping hut caught fire.

It is alleged that, the deceased had dinner with the family and they all went to sleep, midnight one family member went outside to urinate and discovered that the deceased hut was on fire, and the he had burned to death.

The deceased was identified as Johannes Geingob (N/Male, 18 years of age).

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

WANAHEDA POLICE STATION : CULPABLE HOMICIDE

On Friday, 10 June 2016, at about 18h10, at Beijing Street, Otjomuise Location, 2 years old was accidentally cut on the head with a grinder and died later at Katutura State Hospital.

It is alleged that, the suspect (neighbour) is a Carpenter, and he was busy cutting wood with a grinder at his residence, and while turning with the grinder still on, he accidentally cut a two years old girl that was standing behind him.

The victim was rushed to Katutura State Hospital where she later died.

The deceased was identified as Hileni Hwuandi (N/Male, 2 years of age).

The Police have opened a case of Culpable Homicide against the neighbour (Carpenter).

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

KATUTURA POLICE STATION : INQUEST (VEHICLE ACCIDENT)

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 19h22, on the B1 Road, between Okahandja / Windhoek, nearby Okapuka Tannery, the driver of a Volkswagen mini-bus lost control of the vehicle and overturned.

The driver was alone in the vehicle and was pronounced dead at the scene of the accident.

The deceased was identified as Warnet Guy Losper (N/Male, 47 years of age).

The next of kin are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

OSHANA REGION

ONDANGWA POLICE STATION : INQUEST (VEHICLE ACCIDENT)

On Sunday, 12 June 2016, at about 01h00, on the gravel road between Onamungudo and Onhuno Villages, the driver of Toyota Corrolla (sedan) lost control of the vehicle and hit against a palm tree, he was pronounced dead at the scene of the accident.

The driver was alone in the vehicle at the time of the accident, and he was identified as David Angula (N/Male, 58 years).

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

OSHIKOTO REGION

OMUTHIYA POLICE STATION : RECKLESS AND OR NEGLIGENT DRIVING

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 14h24, on the gravel road between Omuthiya Town and Onanke Village, at Onamulele Village, the driver of a GWM Pick-Up vehicle lost control and overturned.

The driver (N/Male, 39 years of age) was alone in the vehicle at the time of the accident, and he sustained serious injuries and was admitted to Omuthiya State Hospital in a critical condition.

Police investigations into the matter continue.

OSHIVelo POLICE STATION : ATTEMPTED MURDER (READ WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ACT), NEGLIGENTLY HANDLING A FIREARM, DISCHARGING A FIREARM IN A PUBLIC PLACE

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 21h00, at Cham Cham Village, Oshivelo Area, 49 years old man locked his partner (female, 30 years old) in the room with their one year old toddler and fired three shots into the room through the locked door.

No person was injured, the Police have arrested the suspect (N/Male, 49 years) and confiscated the firearm. The suspect is due to appear at Tsumeb Magistrate Court on Monday, 13 June 2016.

OHANGWENA REGION

EENHANA POLICE STATION : RAPE AND ASSAULT GBH

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 00h30, at Jansen Road, Enhana, 20 years old woman was hit with a stone on the forehead and forced into a sexual encounter by a 17 years old male suspect.

According to the victim, she was on her way from church, when the suspect approached her and allegedly grabbed her on the neck and overpowered her. The suspect laid the victim on

the ground and forced her into a sexual encounter and hit her with a stone on the forehead and she sustained an open wound.

The suspect (N/Male, 17 years of age) is arrested and is due to appear at Eenhana Magistrate Court on Monday, 13 June 2016.

EENHANA : INQUEST (PERSON FOUND DEAD)

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 06h30, at Oshaango Cuca Shops, a body of a 42 years old man was found next to the Oshaango Cuca Shops.

The deceased was identified as David Amutenya (N/Male, 42 years of age).

The cause of death is unknown at this stage, a post-mortem will be performed to determine to determine the exact cause of death.

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

KAVANGO WEST REGION

KAHENGE POLICE STATION: MURDER

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, between 00h00 and 03h00, at Mpungu Vlei village, 47 years old man died after he was hacked with a traditional axe on the face.

Information surrounding the incident is still sketchy, but the leading allegations are that the deceased was at the Cuca Shops on Friday night at Mpungu Vlei Village, and when it closed, he left the Cuca Shops in the company of two men. He was found dead a few hours later after he was hacked with a tradition axe.

The deceased was identified as Nghudileko Nambobola (N/Male, 47 years of age).

The Namibian Police Force at Mpungu Vlei village has picked up a 40 years old man for questioning.

Importantly, the Namibian Police Force would like to thank the residents of Mpungu Vlei Village for the assistance rendered to the Namibian Police Force in the investigation of this Murder incident.

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

ZAMBEZI REGION

IMPALILA POLICE STATION : INQUEST (DROWNING)

On Friday, 10 June 2016, during the night, at Zambezi River, nearby Balasinte Area, Impalila Island, 40 years old man drowned when his Canoe capsized.

It is alleged that, the deceased was paddling his Canoe on the way to check up on his fishing nets and his Canoe capsized and he drowned.

The deceased was identified as Malumba Ernest Songa (N/Male, 40 years of age).

The next of kin are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

OTJOZONDJUPA REGION

OKAHANDJA POLICE STATION : CULPABLE HOMICIDE

On Friday, 10 June 2016, at about 17h00, on the B1 Road, between Okahandja / Windhoek, almost 20 Km to Okahandja, the driver of the white Quantum Bus travelling from the direction of Windhoek towards Okahandja lost control of the vehicle and overturned.

It is alleged that, the driver was overtaking and lost control and overturned, and collided with a stationery Toyota Pick-Up vehicle (belonging to the Road Construction Company working on Okahandja / Windhoek road) that was parked alongside the road.

There were fourteen (14) occupants in the vehicle, including the driver, whom all sustained serious injuries. Two passengers (male and female) were pronounced dead at the scene of the accident, and the third person (female) died shortly upon arrival at Okahandja State Hospital.

Four people were admitted at Okahandja State Hospital, and seven (7) people including the driver were transferred to Windhoek, six were admitted to Katutura State Hospital, and the driver was admitted to Lady Pohamba Private Hospital where he died on Saturday morning.

The deceased were identified as follows;

1. Anna Lameck (N/Female, 28 years of age)
2. Simon Haingura Abraham (N/Male, 25 years of age)
3. Claudia Kaupangua (N/Female, 31 years of age)
4. Kevin Snyders (N/Male, 36 years of age) was the Driver.

They were all employees of Namibia Poultry Farm and were residents of Okahandja Town.

The next of kin are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

OMUSATI REGION

ONANDJABA POLICE STATION : INQUEST (DROWNING)

On Friday, 10 June 2016, at about 14h00, at Dolphin Location Cuca Shops, at Okathima Ka Nangolo Village, in Okalongo Constituency, one year and six months old boy drowned in a container of home brew (Tombo).

It is alleged that the deceased was with grandmother at the Cuca Shops, he was playing outside and the grandmother was inside the cuca shop. The grandmother left to the nearby Cuca shop and when she returned she found the deceased drowned in the container of the home brew (Tombo).

The deceased was identified as Antonia Timoteus Amunyela, a boy of one year and six months old.

The next of kin are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.

OUTAPI POLICE STATION : CULPABLE HOMICIDE

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 18h00, on the main road between Oshakati / Outapi, at Onokolo Village, two vehicles a White Toyota Hilux 2.7 Pick-Up and a white Toyota VVTI Pick-Up collided headon.

The Toyota Hilux was returning from a funeral and had thirteen (13) occupants, including the driver, and in the Toyota VVTI were only two people, driver and one passenger.

Six people (four females and two males) died, five were pronounced dead at the scene of the accident, one person died later upon arrival at Outapi State Hospital.

Nine (9) people sustained serious injuries and were taken to Outapi State Hospital, where seven of them were later transferred to Oshakati Intermediate Hospital where they are admitted in serious condition.

The next of kin of the deceased are not yet formally informed, therefore the deceased names cannot be revealed.

Police investigations into the matter continue.

KUNENE REGION

KHORIXAS POLICE STATION : MURDER

On Friday, 10 June 2016, at about 23h00, at D.R.C Location, at Twyfel Fontein Settlement, 25 years old man was stabbed with a knife by a 35 years old suspect and died on the spot.

It is not yet clear as to what caused the stabbing, but the deceased was stabbed on the neck and was pronounced dead at the crime scene.

The deceased was identified as Collins Kasaona (N/Male, 25 years).

The Police have opened a case of Murder against the suspect, and the suspect (N/Male, 35 years) is arrested and is due to appear at Khorixas Magistrate Court on Monday, 13 June 2016.

The next of kin of the deceased are already formally informed.

KHORIXAS POLICE STATION : RAPE

On Saturday, 11 June 2016, at about 20h00, at Anties Bar Bersig, Twyfel Fontein Settlement, a 15 years old girl was raped by a 27 years old suspect.

It is alleged that, the suspect met the victim at Anties Bar and lured her into a sexual encounter within the premises.

The suspect (N/Male, 27 years of age) is arrested and is due to appear at Khorixas Magistrate Court on Monday, 13 June 2016.

ERONGO REGION

OMARURU : INQUEST (SUICIDE BY SHOOTING)

On Friday, 10 June 2016, at about 14h10, at Omburo Power Station, at Omaruru, 21 years old man who was employed as a Security Guard by Shimwe Enterprise Security Company shot himself with a Company`s shotgun.

The reason for taking own life is unknown, as there is no suicide note left.

The deceased was identified as Liseli Silenge (N/Male, 21 years of age).

The next of kin are already formally informed, Police investigations into the matter continue.
