WEEKEND CRIME REPORT 06 September 2015

KHOMAS REGION

SUICIDE

On 04/09/2015 at 16H10 at Hereford Street Okuryangava 33 years old Peter Kasilula committed suicide by hanging himself with the rope on a tree in the bushes. No suicide note left behind and police investigations continue. Next of kin have already been informed.

HOUSEBREAKING WITH INTENT TO ROB AND ROBBERY WITH AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

On 02nd September 2015, at 23h30, Becky Street No. 6 Ludwigsdorf, it is alleged that the suspect armed with a fire-arm, knife and machete held the complainant at gunpoint and robbed him off his iPad, cellphone and other valuable items valued at N\$17 000.00. No arrest has been made and police investigation continues.

CULPABLE HOMICIDE

On 04/09/2015 at around 00H25 on the western bypass and Sam Nujoma drive. The deceased was driving on the western by-pass with a vehicle belonging to the Angolan embassy; the vehicle was hit by another vehicle from behind causing it to overturn. The driver was taken to the hospital, however succumbed to injuries later that morning. Deceased is identified as Del Christovo 23 years old. Next of kin is already informed.

HOUSEBREAKING AND THEFT

On 05/09/2015 at about 00H00 at Kunene building suppliers, it is alleged that an unknown suspect used a spade to break into the complainant's office and removed properties with-out owner's consent. One generator and other building materials valued at N\$ 30 000.00 was stolen. No arrest and police investigation continues.

ATTEMPTED MURDER

On 05/09/2015 between the hours of 15H00 – 16H00 at Ompilo and Omuva Street Okuryangava, an argument erupted between two male persons over a girl. The suspect was jealous and hit the victim with a button which he grabbed from a security guard who wanted to intervene. He then went to fetch a fire-arm and shot the victim through the left leg. Suspect was not arrested yet and police investigation continues.

DEALING WITH CANABIS

Trans Kalahari CR 02/09/2015

On 05/09/2015 at about 16H00, it is alleged that the suspects drove a minibus from Swaziland on route to Windhoek. At Trans Kalahari border post, a police officer on duty at the entry point into Namibia became suspicious and ordered the minibus to go through the scanner where parcels of dagga were discovered hidden in the roof of the minibus. 29 parcels of dagga were seized and two Swazi nationals were arrested (26 years old and 27 years old). The dagga weight 25 808 kg with street value of N\$ 129 040.00

RECKLESS AND NEGLIGENT DRIVING

On Saturday 5 September 2015 at about 18H00 on B1 road about 9KM from Gibeon, the driver of a Toyota Sedan lost control of the vehicle, causing a vehicle to overturn and the driver sustained serious injuries. The driver was identified as 63 years old from Ongwediva.

HOMICIDE

Gibeon CR 03/09/2015.

On Saturday 05 September 2015 at about 16H05, the driver of a white Toyota Truck registration number BB 98 TR GP lost control of the vehicle, causing it to overturn and driver sustained serious injuries. The incident happened on district road D3910. The driver was alone in the truck N/M 34 years old residing in Rehoboth, Block B.

CULPABLE HOMICIDE

Mariental CR 04/09/2015.

On Friday 04/09/2015 at about 17H25, the driver of a Mitsubishi Truck hit a pedestrian, a 7 year old boy who died instantly. The deceased was identified as Daniel Dera Lukert residing at Aimablaagte. The next of kin were informed.
