MEDIA BRIEFING: REPORTED WEEKEND SERIOUS CRIMES: 08 - 10 July 2016

No serious incidents were reported in the following Regions over the weekend Oshana, Otjozondjupa Oshikoto Ohangwena and Omaheke Region.

Khomas Region

Inquest

On 9 July 2016 at about 01:00 hour at the corner of Beijing and Delhi Street Otjomuise the body of an adult Namibian male was discovered. The Deceased was identified as Nicolino Jossob there were no visible injuries on the body and an autopsy will be conducted to determine the exact cause of death. Next of kin informed Police investigation continue

In Possession of Drugs Windhoek CR 265/07/2016

On 9 July 2016 at about 02:00h at the boiler room Bar, Warehouse Theatre in Tal Street a 32 years old Namibian male was found in possession of one Bullet of Cocaine with the street value of N\$ 500.00. The discovery was made by a security guard during a routine search, he then alerted the Police and the suspect was arrested and is due to appear in court on Monday 11 July 2016.

Kavango West Rundu Inquest 21/2016

On Saturday 9 July 2016 at around 04:00h at Sauyemwa Compound a four (4) month old female baby Sindimba Hermine Makena was discovered dead by the Parents when they woke up in the morning, it further alleged that both parents slept in the same bed with the baby. It is suspected that the baby may have died of suffocation. Police Investigation continue

Reckless and negligent Driving Rundu CR 60/07/2016

On 9 July 2016 at about 21:00h on the Sauyemwa Rundu Nkurenkuru road Vehicle with registration number N 1185 RU a black Nissan Sedan rear ended a BMW with

registration N 3434 Ru while allegedly attempting to overtake, causing serious injuries to the occupants in both vehicles.

The driver of the Nissan was identified as Kambinda Nicodemus 29 year's old Namibian male, while the driver of the BMW was Identified Siwombe Sakaria an adult Namibian male and her passenger was Sophia Thinguru, 29 years of age. The passengers in the Nissan were Boniface Thinguru an adult Namibian Male, and another female passenger only Identified as Gulu.

Kunene Region Theft out of Motor Vehicle

On Saturday 9 July 2016 at about 15:00h at Kamanjab Porcupine Lodge. It is alleged that the victim a German National Parked his car at the lodge and went to the reception, and fifteen minutes later when he return to the vehicle he found the vehicle broken into and the following items were missing 2 x Cameras 1 x Samsung cell phone 1x Binocular 1 x Tripod 1 x Back pack and some NWR documents. Total value of the stolen Items are estimated to the value of N\$ 20 000.00. The Police followed the foot prints that went in the direction of the location and in the process found the flight tickets. No one has yet been arrested in connection with the incident and Police Investigation continues.

Erongo Region Arson

On 8 July 2016 at about 10:55h at Orwetoveni Mondesa 22 Ghetto Shacks caught fire and burned down to ashes. All property contained therein where destroyed. The cause of the fire is unknown. No one was injured during the incident and Police Investigation continue

Drowning

On 8 July 2016 at about 10:55, a male person estimated to be between the ages of 20 to 30 years was swimming in the sea nearby the Tug Boat Restaurant when suddenly he was swept away by the waves. The rescue team that arrived 25 minutes later contacted a search and found the remains of the victim who at the time of the incident was not identified.

The Police were busy trying to identify the deceased and to inform the next of kin

Dealing in Drugs

On 8 July 2016 at about 18:30 in Walvisbay a 23 year old male Zambian National was arrested after he was found in possession of ten bullet of Cocaine with a street value of N\$ 50 000.00, as well as N\$ 18 000.00 in cash. The suspect is due to appear in Walvisbay magistrate court, Tomorrow 11 July 2016.

Zambezi Region Murder Katima CR 36/07/2016

On 6 July 2016 at about 02:00h at the Namibian University of Science and Technology (NUST) It is alleged that a Security guard Employed by Royal Security Company, shot and killed a suspected intruder who allegedly broke into a vehicle at the premises of the university. The suspect died at the scene while his accomplice manages to run away.

The Security guard hand surrendered himself to the Police.

The deceased was Identified as 21 years old Denis Mubita Mubita.

The 52 year old Security guard has not been formally charged and Police investigation Continue.

Culpable Homicide

On 9 July 2016 at about 05:00h on the Ngoma Katima Mulilo road the driver of a Toyota Hilux 2.7 with registration number N 9448 SH Fatally ran over a person who is suspected to have been lying on the road. The deceased was Identified as Zambwe Joseph Manguni 34 years old Namibian Male. Next of kin informed Police Investigation continues.

Omusati Region Murder Etayi CR 4/7/2016

On Friday 8 July 2016 at about 03:00h at Ndemutyavela Shebeen at Okashopasha village Etayi constituency it is alleged that the suspect who is a security guard at Ndemutyavela shebeen allegedly fired a pistol at suspected burglars who were attempting to rob the shebeen and allegedly hit one of the suspect's robbers. The suspected robbers then retreated got into their vehicle and drove away. It is further alleged that the suspected robber who shot died while in the company of his accomplice, in the getaway car, after which his Partners in crime allegedly threw him out of the getaway car. The corpse was discovered the next morning at Onalukono village in Oshana Region. The Deceased was Identified 32 year old Asser Shilomboleni Shikongo who hails from Oipapakane village in Ohangwena Region. A statement was obtained from the Security guard and will be forwarded to the PG for her decision.

Inquest Okahao Inquest 28/2016

On 10 July 2016 at about 06:00h behind Okahao Police Station, 26 years old Sevelen Nekongo from Etakambaye village hanged himself with an electric wire on that thorn tree behind Okahao Police Station. No suicide note was left behind. No foul Play suspect. Next of kin informed.

Inquest Outapi Inquest 19/2016

On 8 July 2016 at an unknown time, but during the day 26 year old Hilifilwa Fillipus Vataleni hanged himself with a rope on a Maroela tree behind their homestead at Omolho village. He was discovered by relatives on the same day at around 18:00h. No Foul play suspected Next of Kin informed

Inquest Outapi Inquest 20/2016

On 8 July 2016 at an unknown time but during the day a Seven year old Angolan girl went to fetch water at a nearby well but never return on investigation her bucket was found in the well. The Police were alerted and later retrieved her body from the well. The deceased was identified as 7 year old Natalie Jonas Angolan Nation. Next of Kin informed.

Hardap Region Rape

On 9 July 2016 at about 13:40h a 20 year old female was raped by 34 year old suspect. It is alleged that the victim was walking from Gibeon to the T junction to catch a hike to Keetmanshoop when the suspect allegedly followed her and raped her. Police Investigation continue
