SUBJECT: DAILY CRIME REPORT: 11 OCTOBER 2017

OHANGWENA REGION

Ohangwena - Incident Report - On 10 October 2017 at about 03h30 near Okatwitwi location East side of Oshikango border post an unknown male person who was about to cross the Namibia-Angola borders dropped a bag containing 5.2 kg of Cannabis, valued at N\$15 000-00, into a water dam after he spotted the Namibian Police border patrol guards trying to stop him. He allegedly fired shots at the patrol guards and he ran back into Angola. Police investigation continues.

Ohangwena CR 28/10/2017-Robbery

On 10 October 2017 at around 14h17, Ohangwena town, behind Pönhofi Secondary School, it is alleged that two suspects robbed the complainant of his bag containing cash to the amount of N\$35 000-00. The money was not recovered, the complainant, a male 60 years old is a retired police officer and he was robbed in the

company of his wife. Suspects are unknown and not yet arrested. Police investigation continues.

OSHIKOTO REGION

Oshivelo- Suicide

On 10 October 2017 at about 06h00 at farm Vryheid no.888 South of Oshivelo, the body of 49 years old Christopher Kamati was found hanging from a rope on a tree by co-farm workers, in front of the farm main house. He is a suspect in a stock theft case at Oshivelo. No suicide note left. The body was transported to Tsumeb Police Mortuary for a post mortem. Police investigation continues.

Oshivelo CR- Bribery

On 10 October 2017 at Oshivelo checkpoint, it is alleged that a 36 years old male Chinese national bribed a police officer on duty with N\$200.00 while performing his duties. It is further alleged that the suspect placed the money in the hand of the police officer in order to let them pass the gate after his Chinese companion, a passenger in his vehicle, failed to produce his Passport upon request by the police officer. They were both arrested and are expected to appear in court. Police investigation continues.

ERONGO REGION

Henties Bay CR 06/10/2017- Culpable Homicide

On 10 October 2017 at about 09h30 on the road between Henties Bay and Ugab gate, it is alleged that the driver of a dark blue Toyota Corolla, lost control over the vehicle due to a tyre puncture. The vehicle veered off the road and overturned. There were three (03) passengers, including a two year old baby boy, onboard. The driver and one passenger died on the spot. The other passenger and the baby sustained serious injuries and they were transported to Swakopmund State Hospital for medical treatment. The baby is in a critical condition while the other passenger is in a stable condition. The deceased were identified as 26 years old David Byl (driver) and 45 years old Matheus Haufiku (passenger). The deceased bodies were transported to the Police mortuary for Post Mortem report. Next of kin were informed. Police investigation continues.

OMUSATI REGION

Etayi Inquest 14/2017- Suicide

On 10 October 2017 at around 07h30 at Okahma shebeen, Onangula village; it is alleged that the deceased hanged himself with a rope fastened on a plank inside the shebeen. No suicide note was found. The deceased is identified as Nekwaya Benhard Ngenowahala, Namibian male, 35 years old. Next of kin was informed and Police investigation continues.

Oshikuku Inquest 10/2017- UNNATURAL DEATH (GUNSHOT)

On Wednesday 11 October 2017 at about 06h00 at Omulondo, Oshuungu village, , it is alleged that the deceased shot himself with a shotgun in his sleeping room. No suicide note was found and no foul play suspected. The deceased was identified as Tshifugula Nyanyukweni Pandeni, a 44 years old Namibian male. He is a Lecturer at Oshakati Unam Campus. Next of kin has been informed. Police investigation continues.

HARDAP REGION

Culpable Homicide

On 10 October 2017 at about 21h11 on Mariental- Kalkrand main road, the deceased Sageus Tsamarab was first bumped by a white Toyota Hilux 2.4 and again by an unidentified sedan vehicle. Both vehicles failed to stop after the accident. Next of kin have been informed. Anyone with information is requested to contact the Mariental Police Station. Police investigation continues.

KOMAS REGION

Windhoek CR 242/10/2017- Culpable Homicide

On 10 October 2017 at about 06h30, Hosea Kutako drive near the new office of the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration, Windhoek North, the deceased was crossing the road when he was fatally hit by a car. The deceased was identified as Cloete Adolf Gerhard a Namibian male aged 60. His next of kin was informed. Police Investigation continues.
