Hardap Region Aranos Murder

On Thursday 30 November 2017 between 01:00 & 02:00 at Farm Hoop, Aranos, at the workers' residents near the foreman's house. It is alleged that the deceased Daniel Nghilokwa Haidula 30 years old Namibian male died on the scene, when he was stabbed by the suspect 23 years Namibian male with a knife, on the right upper chest. It is further alleged that the deceased asked the suspect why he was not at work the previous day, this resulted in a quarrel between the two and it led to the fatal stabbing. The next of kin was informed and the suspect handed himself over to the Police and he was arrested. He is expected to appear in court next week and Police investigation continues.

Mariental Dealing in Cannabis

On Friday 30 November 2017 at around 03: 20 at Mariental Wimpy (truck pot) at the hike point to Gibeon. It is alleged that the suspect 17 years old Namibian male was found in possession 13xParcells of Pure Cannabis of 3.27kg to the value of N\$33,000-00. The suspect was arrested and Police investigation continues.

Rehoboth found possession of cannabis and mandrax

On Thursday 30 November 2017at about 12h30 at Erf 2155 Block E Rehoboth. It is alleged that three suspects aged 35 Namibian male, 28 and 25 years old Namibian female were found in possession of 2 x full mandrax tablets, 3 x half mandrax tablets and 82 ballies of dagga after a Police search was conducted. The value of the items was N\$ 1200-00. All three (3) suspects are in Police custody and Police investigation continues.

Rehoboth in Possession cannabis plants

On Thursday 30 November 2017 at about 16h30 at farm Benades Pan Rehoboth District. It is alleged that the suspect Namibian male age unknown was found in possession of 19 trees of cannabis plants after a Police search was conducted. The value of the items is unknown and the suspect was not arrested. Police investigation continues.

Mariental Drunk & Driving

On Thursday 30 November 2017 about 22:50 on the B1 road about 10km from Mariental, to the northern side near roadblock. It is alleged that the suspects aged 53 and 55 years old Namibian male who both were drivers, were arrested on the scene for Drunk and Driving. It is further alleged that one of the drivers bumped the other vehicle from behind causing damages to both vehicles. Both suspects were arrested and Police investigation continues.

Karas Region Luderitz Dealing in drugs

On Thursday 30 November 2017 at about 16:30 on the B1 road to Aus at the Welcome sign, near Natis Luderitz. It is alleged that a motor vehicle was stopped and pulled off by the Traffic Law Enforcement Unit members. It is further alleged that after a Police search the suspect was found in possession of 150 mandrax tablets to the value N \$9000-00. The suspect is 51 years old Namibian male and he was arrested and is expected to appear in court soon. Police investigation continues.

Kunene Region Khorixas Suicide

Between Wednesday 29 November 2017 and Thursday 30 November 2017 at BTG 30 Location Khorixas. It is alleged that the deceased 41 years old Theopoltine Goreses Namibian female, hanged herself with a rope in their sleeping room. It is further alleged that the victim was with her children and boyfriend at home, the kids and the boyfriend went to bed while she was reading her bible. And in the morning when they woke up they saw the victim hanging with the rope in the same room, no suicide note was left behind. The next of kin was informed and a post-mortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death. Police investigation continues.

Erongo Region Mondesa Murder

On Thursday 30 November 2017 between 21:00 and 22:00 near Oshitambi Bar at DRC, Mondesa. It is alleged that the deceased 24 years old Sitentu Frans Imarwa, Namibian male died after he was stabbed with an unknown object. It is further alleged that the victim was last seen in Oshitambi bar, at DRC suburb by his friends while buying a cool drink for a lady, and thereafter he allegedly left the bar with the said lady. It is further alleged that the deceased was later seen being attacked and stabbed with an unknown object by unknown two (2) male persons (suspects). His dead body was later found lying in a pool of blood in the street near Oshitambi bar with a deep cut wound on the right chest. The next of kin were informed and the body of the deceased was taken to Walvis Bay Police Mortuary for post mortem examination to determine the cause of death. The suspects were not yet arrested and the mentioned lady was brought in for questioning. Police investigation continues.

Kavango West Region Kahenge Kidnapping

On Thursday 30 November 2017 at around 14:30 at Nankudu State Hospital. It is alleged that the victim a 1 month old male baby was kidnapped by the suspect an adult Namibian female from Kahenge village. It is further alleged that the victim's mother a 15 years old Angolan left the baby in the care of her niece an 11 year old Angolan female, whilst she was receiving medical attention. It is also further alleged that the suspect who was in the same ward sent the girl who was left with the baby to go buy for her bread and cool drink at the nearby shop. Upon the girl's return the suspect had away with the victim, immediately the Police was notified, a search was conducted immediately and the suspect was apprehended with the baby. The baby was reunited with the mother while the suspect was arrested and is in police custody. Police investigation continues.
