SUBJECT: DAILY CRIME REPORT: 12 SEPTEMBER 2017

Oshikoto Region Onayena Inquest

On 10 September 2017 around 04h00, at Inongo village Okakwiyu area Oniipa constituency. It is alleged that the deceased 52 years old Namibian male from Onakaheke Omusati Region was found dead in his sleeping room by his wife. Next of kin is informed and a post mortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death.

Hardap Region

Klein-Aub Reckless and or negligent driving

On Sunday 10 September 2017 at about 12h00, on the Rehoboth/Klein Aub C-4 gravel road. It is alleged that driver a 41 years old female of a white 2.7 D/C Toyota pickup lost control over the vehicle and it overturned in the middle of the road and it fell on its roof. It is further alleged that there were 04 occupants in the vehicle whereby one of them sustained serious internal injuries on her left shoulder and the other three only slight injuries. All were taken to

Rehoboth State Hospital for treatments. The vehicle is a rental car from Aloe rental and it was seriously damaged. Police investigation continues.

Khomas Region
Wanaheda Inquest

On Monday 11 September 2017 around 00h30, at Erf 665 Outapi Street, Havana. It is alleged that the deceased 44 years old Namibian male died after his shack caught fire. It is further alleged owner who was alone inside burnt to death and the cause of death is unknown. Next of kin is informed and Police investigation continues.

Klein Windhoek Housebreaking with intent to Rob and robbery with aggravating circumstances

On Monday 11 September 2017 between 21h00 and 00H00, at no. 22 Cathy Street – Ludwisdorf, Klein Windhoek. It is alleged that five (5) masked men, three (3) armed with firearms held the victim 23 years old Namibian male Security Guard of Namibian Protection Services at gunpoint and tied him up in the garage. It is further alleged that the suspects robbed off the victim of his Cellphone a black Samsung with tango pre-paid card and they tied him up. It is further alleged that the robbers remained in the garage for the arrival of the home owner at his residence. Upon the arrival of the owner the robbers grabbed him from his vehicle a station wagon Rand Cruiser and they assaulted him and the later tied him on the wrist with a string. They robbed him of his crocodile leather belt, two (2) Cell phones both Samsung Galaxy S6, a Samsung mini and a laptop. The suspects fled the scene through the backyard of the house, which is also the entry point. Armed response from G4s received the report from control room G4s, arrived at the scene at and rescued the two (2) victims. Both victims are in stable condition with minor injuries. No arrest were made and Police investigation continues.

Erongo Region
Kuisebmond Illegal Abortion

On Sunday 10 September 2017 at unknown time, at house no.1437. Harder Crescent. Street, Kuisebmond

It is alleged that the suspect 26 yrs old Namibian female who was two months pregnant approached a certain lady 26 yrs old who is another suspect to assist her by terminating her pregnancy. It is further alleged that the suspect who was approached by the first suspect inserted a stick her vagina on the Saturday 09 September 2017 at around 10:00. And on Sunday, 10 September 2017 at around 10h00 the suspect who was inserted a stick in her vagina started bleeding, she removed the stick and the pregnancy was terminated. Both

suspects were arrested and suspect no. 2 was admitted at Walvis Bay State Hospital in a stable condition under Police guard. Police investigation continues.

Omaruru Burglary

On Monday 11 September 2017 at about 03h00, at Bank Windhoek Omaruru Branch. It is alleged that the alarm at the premises went off and the security guard on duty inspected and went in front of the bank and found all was in order but did not inform the Police. It is further alleged that it was only discovered at around 07h00 by the bank employees when they reported for duty that the fence behind the bank was cut and the suspects proceeded to cut the bank window's burglar bars with a cutting torch, gained entrance, and also cut the alarm wires. It is further alleged that the suspects proceeded and tried to open the safe room but could not manage. At this moment nothing was noticed to have been stolen only the damages caused. No arrests have been made so far and Police investigation continues.

Karibib Suicide

On Monday 11 September 2017 at about 11h00, at a Municipal Plot near the bridge East of Karibib. It is alleged that the body of the deceased a male person believed to be between the ages of 50-60 was discovered by a passerby who was looking for firewood at the Plot. It is further alleged that the deceased was hanging from a tree and had a belt around his neck. The passerby reported the matter to the Police who attended the scene. He was found wearing a cream 777 trouser and a black overall jacket written Quality tyres. No document or suicide note was found in his possession. The body was taken to Walvis Bay Police Mortuary for a post-mortem to be conducted to determine the cause of death. The Police is requesting anyone who miss a relative to approach the Police mortuary in Walvisbay. Police investigation continues.

Rosh Pinah Dealing in Cannabis

On Monday 11 September 2017 at about 12h30, at Rosh Pinah. It is alleged that the suspect a 27 years old Namibian male was found in possession of 1.124 Kg of cannabis (skunk) to an amount of N\$12 400-00. The suspect is arrested and will appear in court soon. Police investigation continues.

Omusati Region

Okahao Culpable Homicide

On Monday 11 September 2017 at around 14h30, on the main road between Oshakati and Okahao at Etunda Village, Okahao Constituency. It is alleged that the driver 36 years old

Namibian male of a white TATA sedan died after he lost control over the vehicle he was driving. It is further alleged that he was driving from east to west on the main road and about 10km before Okahao he lost control over the vehicle and it overturned. The vehicle had five occupants including the driver and all four passengers sustained serious and slight injuries. All were taken to Oshakati State Hospital. The next of kin is informed and Police investigation continues.

Ogongo Rape

On Saturday 29 July 2017 at an unknown, at Oshitutuma village, Ogongo Constituency. It is alleged that the victim a minor 7 years old Namibian female was raped the suspect age unknown Namibian male. It is further alleged that the suspect called the victim to go with him to his and had sexual intercourse with her victim. The suspect is believed to be the neighbour of the victim and he is not yet arrested. Police investigation continues.

Okahao Rape and Theft

On Sunday 10 September 2017 at about 20h00, at Uutsima village, Elim Constituency. It is alleged that the suspect age unknown Namibian male found the victim 53 years old Namibian female walking on her way home from the location. It is further alleged that the suspect grabbed victim on her neck, dragged her down, beat her with fist on her face resulting in her face to get swollen, pouring sand in her eyes and mouth and then undress her and had sexual intercourse with the victim without her consent and also stole the victim's Samsung cellphone, black in colour valued at N\$ 400.00. The suspect who is alleged to be the victim's neighbour was not yet arrested and a search hunt to arrest him is underway. Police investigation continues.
