SUBJECT: DAILY CRIME REPORT: 18 JULY 2017

Khomas Region Katutura Dealing in Drugs

On Monday 17 July 2017 at about 06:00 morning, at the corner of Dan Viljoen and Otjomuise road. It is alleged that two (2) suspects a 43 years old DRC male national and a 47 years old Angolan female national were arrested when found in possession of drugs. It is further alleged that the suspects' motor vehicle a Corolla with Reg. No.N 35540 W skipped a red robot and hit a taxi a Corolla Reg. No. N 152-141 W. It is further alleged that the male suspect after hitting into the taxi he grabbed a bag from his vehicle and tried to flee the accident scene but the taxi driver caught him and stopped him from fleeing. He then informed the Police about the accident and upon their arrival they found a bag of four blocks of suspected cocaine (drugs) in the suspects' vehicle. The weight of the drugs was 4,100kg valued to N\$ 2,000 000-

00 (million). The DRC male national is married to a Namibian female and they were both arrested and are in Police custody. They are expected to appear in court soon and Police investigation continues.

Windhoek Suicide

On Tuesday 18 July 2017 at unknown time alongside the B1 road, Brakwater next to Trans Namib railways. It is alleged that a body of an unknown male person was found hanging on a tree. It is alleged that the deceased hanged himself with a wire. Next of kin not known and Police investigation continues.

Erongo Region

Swakopmund Reckless and or negligent driving

On Sunday 16 July 2017 at about 20:54 at the railway crossing in the vicinity of DRC suburb, Mondesa. It is alleged that the driver Andreas Van Wyk of a motor vehicle, a BMW, with Reg. No. N 21994 S collided with an oncoming train which was travelling from Swakopmund. No injuries sustained only the car which was damaged beyond repair. No arrest made and Police investigation continues.

Mondesa Sudden death

On Monday 17 July 2017 at about 05:00, at DRC location, Mondesa. It is alleged that the body of the deceased 55 years old Petrus Festus was found by Mr. Ruben in his yard. It is further alleged that on Sunday 16 July 2017 at about 15:00 the deceased left his resident at DRC suburb to go and visit a friend also a resident of DRC. The deceased allegedly visited one shebeen and bought one Tassenberg and a beer which they drunk together. After that they went to the friend's ghetto where he spent some time drinking Oshiwambo traditional liquor (Ombike) and he later in the evening left to go home. It is suspected that the deceased was on his way home, while under the influence of alcohol and got tired and tried to look for help but he was unable to walk, he fell down and tried to stand up but he could not. He was declared dead by medical Officials at the scene and no foul play suspected. The next of kin were informed and a post-mortem will be conducted to determine the real cause of the death.

Omusati Region

Outapi Drowning

On Monday 17 July 2017 at around 15:00, at Onembaba village, Outapi Constituency, Omusati Region. It alleged that the deceased 7 years old Endjala Natanael Namibian male went to fetch water and his body was later found by the neighbour floating on top of water well, not far from their homestead. Next of kin informed and a post mortem will be conducted to determined the cause of death and Police investigation continues.

Otjozondjupa Region

Okahandja Murder

On Saturday 15 July 2017 at about 00:40, at Okahandja Ehafo Camp. It is alleged that the deceased 41 years old Erastus Haitete Namibian male died after he was stabbed with a sharp object in the neck and on his back. It is further alleged that the victim went to urinate outside his room and was attacked by unknown suspects. The victim succumbed to his wounds and was found dead at the doorstep of his room. Three suspects 18 years old, 14 years old and 16 years old all Namibian male were arrested and are expected to appear in court soon. Police investigation continues.

Oshana Region

Oshakati Rape

On Sunday 09 July 2017 at about 22:00, at Shoopala location Oshakati. It is alleged that the victim a 7 years old Namibian female minor was raped. It is further alleged that the suspect an Adult Namibian male entered the victim's sleeping room and had sexual intercourse with the minor. The suspect is known but not yet arrested since he ran away. Police investigation continues.

Zambezi Region

Kongola Theft from a Motor Vehicle

On Monday 17 July 2017 between 22:00 evening and Tuesday 06:000, at Namushasha lodge at It is alleged that the owner of the vehicle left the vehicle unlocked and the suspect(s) took his properties out of the car without his consent. The suspect(s) took properties valued at N\$ 26658.00. No recovery and no arrests made. Police investigation continues.

Kavango West Region
Nkurenkuru Rape

On Sunday 16 July 2017 at unknown time, Sheengeenge Farm. It is alleged that the victim 43 years old Namibian female was raped. It is further alleged that the suspect an Angolan national had sexual intercourse with a Namibian female without her consent at the said farm. The suspect was arrested and Police investigation continues.

Kunene Region
Anker Attempted Murder

On Monday 17 July 2017 at 04:00, at farm Langverwag Anker. It is alleged that the victim 19 years old Edwin Araeb Namibian male was stabbed by the suspect 19 years old Namibian female who is his girlfriend twice with a knife, on the left lower rib and top of the breast. The victim was taken to Anker clinic and rushed with an ambulance to Khorixas. The suspect is arrested and Police investigation continues.

Opuwo Reckless and or negligent driving

On Monday 17 July 2017 at 04:00, at Okaoko Otavi Village Opuwo. It is alleged that the victim 29 years old Ruhata Kavara Namibian male was bumped by a motor vehicle and sustained injuries and was taken to Opuwo state hospital where he was hospitalized and is in a stable condition. No arrest made and Police investigation continues.
