SUBJECT: DAILY CRIME REPORT: 08 SEPTEMBER 2017

**Oshana Region
Ongwediva Inquest**

On Thursday 07 September 2017 at about 08 h00, at Ohakwenyanga village. It is alleged that the deceased 79 years old Namibian female decomposed body was found in her bedroom by the family member. It is further alleged that the victim went missing on Saturday 02 September 2017 and allegedly stayed alone at her house. The next of kin is informed and a post mortem will be conducted to determine the exact cause of death.

Ondagwa Inquest

On Thursday 07 September 2017 at 14h00, at Nani Delta Surgery, Ekepi complex, Ondangwa. It is alleged that the deceased 38 yrs old Namibian female collapsed and died. It is further alleged that the deceased was a Dental assistance. Next of kin is informed and a post mortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death.

**Khomas Region
Wanaheda Suicide**

On Thursday 07 September 2017 around 19h20, at Oshitenda location. It is alleged that the victim 49 years Namibian male locked himself in his shack, shot himself once on the side of the head with his licensed 9mm pistol and the bullet exited on the other side of the head near the ear. It is further alleged that the motive for the attempted suicide is not clearly explained but the victim informed his friends that he was annoyed by his family members who took away his documents and gave them away to unknown people. The victim was taken to Katutura State Hospital but passed away today 08 September 2017 at about 02:30. The next of kin is informed and Police investigation continues.

Dordabis Culpable Homicide

On Thursday 07 September 2017 at about 18h45, on the B-6 Road, Dordabis turn off. It is alleged that the deceased 25 years old Namibian male who was the driver of a Toyota Yaris and one passenger died on the spot. It is further alleged that the victim was overtaking at a prohibited area and hit on the side of the truck which he was overtaking. Both the deceased vehicle and the truck were driving in the same direction and the truck was indicating to turn off at the Dordabis turn off. The driver of the Toyota Yaris lost control of the vehicle causing it to overturn and landed on the roof killing the driver and one passenger. Three other passengers sustained minor injuries and the truck driver who was alone sustained minor injuries. Police investigation continues.

Hardap Region

Kalkrand Poaching

On Sunday 06 August 2017 at Farm Karris nr. 08. It is alleged that unknown suspect(s) captured and killed one (1) oryx by stoning it death. The value is determined to be N\$2000-00 and no arrests have been made so far and Police investigation continues.

Ohangwena Region

Ohangwena Suicide

On Thursday 07 September 2017 at about 17 h00, at Okanghudi ka Shapopi. It is alleged that the deceased a Namibian male age unknown hanged himself with a rope on a tree and fell off and the deceased decomposed body was eaten by the dogs. It is further alleged that the deceased was missing for almost a week and was not reported as missing to the police. The next of kin is informed and Police investigation continues.

Oshikoto Region

Onayena Inquest

On Thursday 07 September 2017 at an unknown time, at Onampengu village - Omulingi area at Okankolo constituency. It is alleged that the deceased 46 years old Namibian female hanged herself on a tree with a rope around her neck. No suicide note was left behind and the next of kin is informed. A post mortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death.

Erongo Region

Mondesa Murder

On Friday 01 September 2017 at about 03h00, at the vicinity of Makiti Bar no. 2, Mondesa Single Quarters. It is alleged that the deceased 39 years old Namibian male died when he was stabbed with a knife by an unknown suspect. It is further alleged that the deceased and his co-workers were eating "Kapana" and an unknown suspect stabbed him with an unknown object on the left side of the chest and inflicted a serious open wound. The deceased was taken by the friends to Swakopmund State Hospital in a critical condition whereby he was later transferred to Katutura State hospital, Windhoek but died yesterday 07 September 2017 at

about 07h30. The next of kin is informed and no arrest has been made. Police investigation continues.
