SUBJECT: DAILY CRIME REPORT: 27 NOVEMBER 2017

Kunene Region Kamanjab Culpable Homicide

On Saturday 25 November 2017 around 06:10 between Outjo /Kamanjab main road about 17 km to Kamanjab. It is alleged that the driver of a Hyundai drop side truck with registration number N 129015 W lost control over the truck when the rear right tyre burst and it overturned and one passenger died on the spot. It is alleged that there were five (5) occupants in the truck whereby four (4) sustained serious to minor injuries. All injured persons were transported by an ambulance to Outjo State Hospital for medical treatment and their conditions are reported to be serious but stable. The deceased was identified as Otja Mbaukua age unknown, Namibian male and the next of kin are informed. Police investigation continues.

Hardap Region

Mariental Rape

On Saturday 25 November 2017 round about 02:00 on an open area on the northern side of Persiana Municipality soccer field, Mariental. It is alleged that a 25 years old Namibian female was raped by the suspect age unknown, Namibian male. It is further alleged that the victim went to the bush to go and urinate while alone as she was drinking liquor. It is also alleged that while busy in the bush, four (4) male suspects came across her, they chased her and she ran into a wrong direction and the suspects caught up with her. One (1) of the suspects had sexual intercourse with victim without her consent and left her at the scene afterwards. As the victim was walking back home after the incident, a man who heard the screams as he lives near where the incident took place took her to the Police Station. The suspect is unknown and not yet arrested but the victim can identify him if she sees him. Police investigation continues.

Gibeon Stock Theft

On Saturday 25 November 2017 at about 20:00 at farm Soutpit, Gibeon. It is alleged that the suspects took two(2) sheep from the victim's kraal, where five (5) sheep were kept and went to slaughter them at Aniskobeb without owner's consent. The value of the sheep is N\$3000.00 and the carcasses were not recovered. Three Namibian male suspects age 39, 33 and 21 years old were arrested.

Bethanie Murder

On 26 November 2017 at about 22:00 at Penehafo Shebeen in Bethanie. It is alleged that the deceased Thom Dennis 34yrs was stabbed with a knife and died on the spot by the suspect 24 years old Namibian male. The suspect was arrested and is expected to appear in court soon and Police investigation continues.

Oshana Region

Ongwediva Capable homicide

On Saturday 25 November 2017 around 22:50 at the traffic lights near Select Service Station Ongwediva. It is alleged that the deceased Matty Letu Naliuye Nghitula 28 years old Namibian male who was the driver of a Vitz, navy blue in colour, died on his way to Medipark Hospital, after the driver of a white Quantum in colour, with registration number N 21850 SH which was driving from Oshakati going to Ongwediva collided head on with Vitz, which was coming from Ondangwa going to Ongwediva. It is also alleged that the deceased victim was by the time with his girlfriend in the vehicle but she did not sustain any injuries. The next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.

Khomas Region

Wanaheda Murder

On 26 November 2017 at about 11:00 at Etetewe street, Okulyangava. It is alleged that the deceased 31 years old Samuel Tsei-Tsei, Namibian male, died after he was stabbed with a knife by the suspect age unknown on the left side of the neck. It is further alleged that the deceased and the suspect were fighting and the victim was rushed to Katutura State Hospital and he was declared dead upon arrival. The suspect is known but not yet arrested and next of kin were informed. Police investigation continues.

Otjomuise Murder

On 26 November 2017 about 22:00 in Kitunda Street, 8De Laan, Otjomuise. It is alleged that the deceased Ngatangwe Murangi 21 years old Namibian male and the suspect 33 years old Namibian male were fighting after the suspect allegedly identified his stolen shoes worn by the victim. It is further alleged that the suspect stabbed the deceased with a knife two times, on the chest and on the back and killing him instantly. The deceased has been identified as Suspect is under arrest. . Next of kin is of the deceased was informed and Police investigation continues.

Otjomuise Attempted Murder

On Sunday 26 November 2017 at about 19:00 at a Shebeen on Mamedi street near the Mamedi Kindergarten. It is alleged that the suspect 47 years old Namibian male and the victim Ueyakoyao Uemena 26 years old a Namibian had argument. It is further alleged that and the suspect took out a pistol and shot the victim once on the back and once on the lower abdomen. The victim was admitted in Katutura State Hospital in serious but stable condition while the suspect went to report himself to Otjomuise Police station and he was arrested. The fire arm used was not found yet as the suspect did not want to say much on the matter. The suspect is suspected to appear in court soon and Police investigation continues.

Katutura Murder

On Sunday 26 November 2017 at about 21:57 at Six Bar, Changai Street, Shandumbala. It is alleged that the deceased Mervin Immanuel 24 years old Namibian male died when he was stabbed with a knife on the chest. It is further alleged that the victim was busy with a braai when two suspects came to him. A fight broke out between the suspects and the victim, whereby one of the suspects stabbed him with a knife. He was rushed to Katutura State Hospital and he was declared dead few minutes later. The next of kin were informed and two (2) suspects aged 23 and 21 years old were arrested and are expected to appear in court. Police investigation continues.

Karas Region
Aroab Suicide

On Sunday 26 November 2017 at 06:00 at Farm Swartbas West. It is alleged that the deceased 29 years old Hendrick Hermanus Rooi, Namibian male hanged himself. The deceased body was found hanging on a dam wall by a farm worker of the farm and it is further alleged that the victim walked from Aroab to Farm Swartbas West the same day. No foul play was suspected and no suicide note was left behind. The next of kin was informed and Police investigation continues.

Erongo Region
Walvis Bay Sudden death

On Sunday 26 November 2017 at about 08:00 at Walvisbay, dumping area It is alleged that the deceased Phillipus Mathias, 43 years old was found dead outside his sleeping place at Walvis Bay dumping area, where he usually sleeps. It is further alleged that he did not complain of any health problems and no foul play was suspected. The body was taken to the Walvis Bay Police mortuary for a Post mortem to determine the cause of death. The next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.
