SUBJECT: WEEKEND CRIME REPORT: 17 – 19 November 2017,
14H00

Katutura - Inquest /2017 a body of unknown female was found under the bridge next to Khomasdal cemetery along Florence Nightingale Street at about 11:00hrs on 17/11/2017. The body was lying on a blanket. No external injury on the body and no foul play suspected at this stage but the autopsy will be carried out to determine the cause of death. The next of kin is not yet informed.

Windhoek- Inquest /2017 on 17/11/2017 at about 11:20hrs; a male person identified as Salomo Tuyoleni (51) and member of NDF collapsed in front of Furniture Mart along Independence Avenue. The deceased was allegedly walking when he collapsed and died. His next of kin is informed.

Omitara -Culpable Homicide on 17/11/2017 at about 09h00 Omitara - Otjinene road - it is alleged that a driver (77) was travelling from farm Okoviruru Hochfeld area to Windhoek with four male passengers on his white Mahindra carrying a trailer. The left rear wheel allegedly burst

causing the driver lost control of the vehicle and overturned. One passenger died on the spot, identified as Mupange Moses Mbishi Ndakalimwe (35). The next of kin is informed.

Sesfontein - Inquest on 17/11/2017 at about 07H00 at Okahirongo Elephant Lodge at Puros, Sesfontein constituency, it is alleged that the deceased who was a mechanic at the said lodge was busy repairing the Toyota Land cruiser when he died. An employee working at the laundry found him dead between the vehicle and the wall of the staff residents. The deceased is identified as Martina Michael 30 yrs. Next of kin is informed. Investigation continues and postmortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death.

Opuwo - Inquest 17/2017 Unnatural death on 17/11/2017 around at Orutjandja location; It is alleged that a boy was bitten by a snake at home while asleep and died while on the way to the hospital. The snake was found and killed. The deceased is Kampaku Sean, 5 years old and the next of kin is informed. A postmortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death.

Rehoboth - Murder on 17/11/2017 at about 22:30 at a residence in Block C. Theodore Gotthard Zabel was stabbed with unknown object on his left side of the chest and died on spot. Two suspects 47 years female and 58 years male were detained and police investigation continues.

Kuisebmond - Dealing in mandrax tablets and cannabis, on 17/11/2017 at about 19h45 at a residence in Springbok Street, Kuisebmond. A 30 years old Namibian male was arrested for dealing in 19 halves mandrax tablets and 35 grams of cannabis valued :N\$ 1300-00 during a Police Drug operation.

Kuisebmond - possession of cannabis and mandrax tablets, on 17/11/2017 at about 19h50 at a house in Nathaniel Maxwilili Street, Kuisebmond. A 50 years old Namibian male was arrested for possession of one and half

mandrax tablets and 22 grams of cannabis valued N\$ 370-00 during a Police Drug operation.

Klein Windhoek - Attempted armed robbery on 18/11/2017 at about 01:00 at 37 Dr. Kwame Nkrumah avenue, Ludwigsdorf. It is alleged that Four (4) suspects, one armed with a pistol jumped over a fence wall from behind and opened the glass sliding door and entered the house. The complainant and his son were beaten with iron objects on their heads. The complainant's son managed to fire 3 warning shots and the suspects ran away and did not manage to remove anything. One suspect fired a shot to the victims but none was hit. The complainant, a 72 years old Nam male was seriously injured. No arrest is made yet, police investigations continue.

Klein Windhoek - Armed Robbery at about 17:00 on 17/11/2017 in the mountains behind Eros, it is alleged that two victims were attacked by six robbers while the victims were busy filming for a movie. The victims are from Endemic Productions and were making a video for the South African Musicians. The suspects were wearing balaclavas and armed with knives. When the victims resist co-operating, one male victim was beaten and hit with a large stone. The suspects managed to take valuable worth over N\$400 000-00. Anyone with information about the suspects is requested to contact the nearest police station. Police investigations continue.

Murder - Ongwediva on 18/11/2017 at around 20:00 at Oshipumbu Village at Uufuleta Cucashop, a 51years old man was arrested after he stabbed Ndeumona Raulisius Johannes Naukala, a Namibian Male 50yrs in the chest and died on the spot. It is alleged that the suspect was suspecting the deceased to be dating his girlfriend. The next of kin is informed and police investigation continues.

Ongwediva - Assault GBH on 18/11/2017 at Ondilinawa village at about 20h30; a Police Sergeant was seriously injured by a 52 years old man who

him in the head. The incident happened when the officers were arresting the suspect on a Murder and Assault GBH cases which occurred at a Cuca-shop at Uufuleta, Oshipumbu-Shomugongo village. The suspect is arrested however admitted at Oshakati state hospital as he is reported to be mentally challenged. Police investigation continues.

Onayena - Rape on 18/11/2017 at 14h00 at Okadhila village-Oshigambo area, Oshikoto Region in a house; it is alleged that a 19 years old man sneaked into the sleeping room of a 10years old while she was sleeping and forcefully had sexual intercourse with her. The suspect and the victim are cousins who live in the same house. The suspect is arrested and will appear on 20/11/2017 in Ondangwa Magistrate court. Police investigation continues.

Incident Report on 18/11/2017 around 18:50hrs on Ondangwa/Omuthiya +-30km to Ondangwa B1 road; it is alleged that the driver of a silver Golf was travelling to Ondangwa when the vehicle he was travelling in caught fire and burnt beyond recognition. The cause of fire is unknown. There were four passengers in the vehicle including the driver, two escaped unhurt while the driver and one passenger sustained serious to slight injuries and were taken to Onandjokwe Hospital. Police investigations continue.

Klein Windhoek - Armed Robbery on 18/11/2017 at 20:30hrs at a house in Zenobia street, Ludwigsdorf; it is alleged that suspects entered the complainants house, gun-pointed the victims and stole properties such as: 1x laptop, TV, watches, cellphones, tablets, cash and more items. All stolen items are worth N\$165 600-00. No recovery and no arrest made yet. Police investigation continues.

Kongola - Culpable Homicide on 18/11/2017 at around 13:30hrs, along the Trans-Caprivi high way within Bwabwata National park; it is alleged that the driver lost control of the vehicle after a rear right tire burst and the vehicle overturn. A toddler, 01 year old Congolese national died on the spot. Other occupants sustained minor injuries and received treatment at Sesheke Clinic at Kongola. Police investigation continues.

Walvis Bay incident report - on 18/11/2017 at about 13:00 on the D1983 gravel road toward Utuseb, Walvis Bay area; a Toyota Quest driven by a 33 years old driver allegedly caught fire and burned down completely. The driver was unharmed. Police investigation continues.

Ndiyona - Possession of controlled wildlife product on 18/11/2017 at about 19h00 at Ndonga Linena, Kavango East Region ; two suspects, 37 and 27 years of age, were arrested during a police operation after they were found in possession of a live pangolin valued at N\$100 000-00. The pangolin was recovered and police investigation continues.

Mariental - Stock theft on 17/11/2017 time unknown at farm Voightsgrund; it is alleged that six cattle's were shot and slaughtered by unknown suspects. Four carcasses were removed while two were left at the scene. The value is estimated to be N\$ 60 000.00. Police investigation continues.

Rehoboth - Rape on 18/11/2017 at about 18:45 at Block E; 45 years old man was arrested for raping a 72 years old mentally challenged woman in the nearby bushes. Police investigations continue.

Usakos - Robbery on 18/11/2017 at about 20:00hrs at a house in Moermerberg suburb, Usakos; it is alleged that three unknown black male suspects, speaking Afrikaans, entered the victim's yard while she was

outside busy preparing food for the dog and they grabbed her from behind and tied her up with ropes. The suspects demanded for the victim (61) Bank card and its pin number, the VW bus key as well as the cellphone. Ultimately the suspects took the card, cell phone, a ring and drove around with the victim in her VW bus and went to an ATM where one suspect went to withdraw money (N\$2000, 00) from her account. After that they allegedly parked the vehicle near Welcome to Usakos board, untie her and instructed her to drive home and they left. The victim is staying alone and was not harmed. The total value of stolen items is estimated to be N\$10 000. 00. No arrest and no recovery. Police investigations continue.
