Aussenkher: Inquest

On 16/12/2018 at about 17:18 at Aussenkher Farm, four girls aged 13, 15, 16 and 17 years old respectively drowned in a river. It is alleged that the deceaseds went swimming with one of the deceased's father. Their bodies are not yet retrieved and police investigations continue.

Anker: Inquest

On 16/12/2018 at an unknown time at Makalani Farm, the body of a male person identified as Tangeni Ndafindana Petrus 27 years old was found hanging on a tree with a rope around his neck. It is alleged that the deceased went missing on 15/12/2018. No suicide note was found. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Keetmanshoop: Culpable Homicide

On 16/12/2018 at about 07:00 at about 100Km from Keetmanshoop on the Keetmanshoop/Grunau B1 Highway, a 65 years old male identified as John Felix Davids (driver)

and a 60 years old South African female identified as Susan Julius died on the spot after it is alleged that the driver lost control of the vehicle they were travelling in. Their next of kin are informed and police investigations continue.

Okahandja: Inquest

On 16/12/2018 at about 15:00 at One Stop Engen Service, a 45 years old male identified as Roelof Swart was found seated and upon inspection it was noticed that he was dead. A postmortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Otjiwarongo: Inquest

On 16/12/2018 at about 13:20 at Jesus Christ Ministry, a 30 years old female identified as Elizabeth Haihambo collapsed and died in church. A postmortem will be conducted to determine the cause of death. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Onesi: Inquest

On 15/12/2018 at about 18:00 at Aina Simon Kanana, Onandjandja Village, Onesi Constituency, a body of a male person identified as Imwata Isak Nangolo was found hanging in a corrugated iron room with a rope around his neck. No suicide note was found. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Onayena: Fire Incident

On 15/12/2018 at about 08:00 at Uuyoka Village, Onayena area, a baby girl identified as Asteria Johannes burned in hut where she was left by her mother with a 5 year old boy. It is alleged that her mother and grandmother went to fetch water at the time of the incident. The boy escaped unharmed and police investigations continue.

Oshikango: Inquest

On 14/12/2018 at about 00:00 at Engela State Hospital, a female identified as Ndapewoshali Daniel passed on after she allegedly came to hospital with in labour. It is alleged that a doctor at the hospital injected her, thereafter her condition got worse and she died. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Okahao: House Breaking and Theft

Between 10-16/12/2018 at unknown times at Omukodo Primary School, Okahao, items valued at N\$16 000.00 were stolen after unknown suspect(s) broke into the principal's office. It is alleged that the suspect(s) used an unknown object to break the door to gain entry. Items stolen include one DVD black in color, one radio silver in color and one generator machine. No recovery or arrest yet made and police investigations continue.

Etayi: Prevention of Corruption

On 15/12/2018 at about 00:30 at Ongenga Nakambebe Location, Okandi Village, a 54 years old male driver was arrested after he was found loading a gambling machine into a Government vehicle that belongs to the Ministry of Education. It is further alleged that the trip authority was only to be utilized in Ohangwena Region but he was arrested in Omusati Region. Police investigations continue.

Eheke: Inquest

On 14/12/2018 at about 21:49 at Etamba Village, Eheke, a body of a male person identified as Jason Itan 29 years old was found hanging on a maroela tree in his father's homestead with a rope around his neck. No suicide note was found. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Onandjamba: Inquest

On 15/12/2018 at about 06:00 at Onandjamba Village, Okalongo Constituency, a body of a female person identified as Monika Ndahaka Ndeinoma 46 years old was found hanging in her sleeping room with a rope around her neck. She was last seen by her house mate on 14/12/2018 at 20:00. No suicide note was found. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Tsandi: Culpable Homicide

On 14/12/2018 at about 22:30 on the Iikokola gravel road, Tsandi Constituency, a male person identified as Sam Shafiishuna Negongo 29 years old died on the spot. It is alleged that he lost control of the motor vehicle he was driving causing it to overturn. The next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Usakos: Rape

On 11/12/2018 at about 20:00 at Rooidak Farm, Spitzkoppe area, a 9 year old female was raped by a 56 years old male suspect. The suspect who is a cattle herder was arrested and is expected to appear in court on 17/12/2018.

Usakos: Possession of Cannabis

On 14/12/2018 at about 11:30 at Engen Service Station, a 48 years old female was arrested after she was searched and found in possession of 1000g cannabis valued at N\$1000.00. Police investigations continue.

Oshakati: Arson

On 15/12/2018 at about 00:55 at Oshakati State Hospital, I.C.U ward, a fire erupted in the nurses' dressing room causing damages to the ceiling and other part of the building. No casualties were recorded. The cost of damage is not yet determined and the cause of the blaze is unknown. Police investigations continue.

Wanaheda: Attempted Murder

On 14/12/ 2018 at about 20h00 at Uukwamatsi Bar no.6 Havana, a 24 year old male and a 40 year old female were allegedly accidentally shot with a firearm by an employee of Shilimela Security Services. It is alleged that a group of people started arguing in the bar and the security guard on duty tried to get them out of the bar. They allegedly became violent and he fired a warning shot but one of the group members continued moving towards him and kicked him, whereby it is alleged that the firearm went off again injuring the two people. The suspect is arrested and police investigation continues.

Klein Windhoek: Robbery

On 15/12/2018 at about 17:00 at Drakenberg, a female (age not given) was robbed of her items by a taxi driver. It is alleged that the suspect pulled the victim from the vehicle and drove off with her belongings which includes: an ipone, one laptop and documents. The value of the stolen items not yet determined. Police investigations continue.

Okondjatu: Murder

On 16/12/2018 at about 20:00 at Okandjatu location, a male person identified as Mike Hauta 33 years old died on spot after he was allegedly stabbed with a knife on the left side of his shoulder by a male suspect. The suspect is arrested. The deceased's next of kin is informed and police investigations continue.

Keetmanshoop: House Breaking with Intent to Steal and Theft

On 16/12/2018 at an unknown time at a residential, Tseiblaagte, a 28 years old male suspect broke into the house and stole cash amount of N\$32 500.00. It is alleged that he used an unknown object to break into the house. The suspect was arrested and an amount of N\$2 500.00 was recovered. Police investigations continue.

Otjomuise: Rape

On 17/12/2018 at about 03:00 at Otjomuise, a 20 years old female was allegedly threatened and held at knife point by four unknown male persons. It is alleged that the victim was knocking at the door of a house when the suspects grabbed and dragged her from the house yard to the riverbed and raped her. No suspect is yet arrested and police investigations continue.
