Rosh Pinah- Dealing in Cannabis on 27 September 2018, during a Police operation at a residence at Tutungeni Location. After a police search, a bag of cannabis valued at N\$10 000-00 was confiscated. The suspect 33 years old is arrested and due to appear before court on 01/10/2018. Police investigation continues.

Outapi - Rape / Robbery, Outapi on 28 September 2018 at about 19h49 at Omundjalala Village behind Olufuko area; It is alleged a 44 years old woman was overpowered, threatened with a knives and raped by an Angolan man. The man also robbed her of cash money (700.00), a cellphone and fled with her handbag containing personal items and official documents. The suspect is arrested and due to appear at Outapi Magistrate Court in today, 01 October 2018. Police Investigation continues.

Aranos - Rape on Saturday 29 September 2018 about 00:15 in the nearby bushes between Rooiduin location and Nuwerus informal settlement, it is alleged that the victim (23) was lured from her house into the bushes by the suspect and raped. The Suspect 23 year old is arrested and investigation continues.

Otjimbingwe - Murder on Friday, 28 September 2018 at about 22:00 at a local bar; Karlos Ngairo, 19 years old succumbed from injuries after he was stabbed with a sharp object in the neck. The suspect 17 years old fled from the scene the next of kin is informed. Police Investigation continues.

Okombahe - Attempted Murder on Saturday 29 September 2018 about 03:08 at Tandango bar; 22 years old man was stabbed four times with an unknown sharp object by the suspect after a fight. He sustained serious injuries and admitted Omaruru state hospital in a critical condition. The suspect fled and thus not yet arrested. Police investigations continue.

Oshakati - Murder on 29 September 2018 at about 00:30 at Sky location; 20 years old George Tuutleni Shaningwa succumbed to injuries on the way to the hospital after he was stabbed in the chest with a knife. The suspect is arrested however admitted in Hospital where he is receiving treatment after he was beaten up by members of the public. The next of kin is informed and police investigation continues.

Epako - Murder on 29 September 2018 about 01:30 at Epako, Damara block; it is alleged that Ransley Kharigub 22 years old was stabbed with a knife and died on the spot after a quarrel between two groups. A 26 years old suspect is arrested. The next of kin of the deceased is informed. Police investigation continues.

Ondangwa - House breaking and theft on 28 September 2018, at about 0830hrs, at a residence in Shinime Simvula location. A suspect (18) who was out on bail for housebreaking cases was arrested after he broke into a house and stole two laptops, six cell phones and other items valued at N\$71 349-00. All stolen items were recovered and police investigation continues.

Aranos - Murder on 29 September 2018 about 18:50 in the street of Nuwerus location, the suspect 16 years old girl stabbed 17 years old Leticia Jaarse with an okapi knife killing him instantly. The motive behind her action is unknown. The next of kin of the deceased are informed. The suspect is arrested and due to appear in Court. Police investigation continues.

Oshakati - Culpable Homicide on 29 September 2018 about 2000hrs at Okamwandi on the Oshikuku main road; 21 years old Protatius Dominika Diina dies instantly after she was bumped by the driver (29) of a Mercedes Benz who was busy overtaking another car. It is alleged that the deceased was standing alongside the road, about to cross. The next of kin is informed and police investigation continues.

Etayi - Reckless and Negligence Driving on 29 September 2018 at about 20h00 at Onalunghono village, Etayi Constituency, a 24 years old man was bumped by the driver (35) of a Honda vehicle while crossing the road. The victim sustained serious injuries and admitted at Oshakati State Hospital in a critical condition. No arrest is made and Police investigation continues.

Okahao - Murder on 29 September 2018 at about 23h40 at Omakeendali location, Okahao town; Joseph Shapaka 26 years old died instantly after he was stabbed with an unknown sharp object in the chest. The motive of the murder is not known so far. The next of kin is informed. The suspect 26 years old is arrested and due to appear in Okahao magistrate court today, Monday the 01 October 2018 Police investigation continues.

Aussenkher - Rape on 30 September 2018 at about 01:45 at block 5 Aussenkher; it is alleged that the suspect had sexual intercourse with the victim (23) without her consent. The suspect 26 years old is arrested and to appear before Karasburg Court today, Monday the 01 October 2018 Police investigation continues.

Okakarara - Murder on 30 September 2018 at 13:30 at Okahitua bar in Okakarara; a 50 years old man from Orunahi, shot Kavehimbiraeua Karokohe 23 years old with a licensed pistol on the right shoulder, killing him instantly. It is alleged that the action was as a result of an argument over alcohol. The next of kin of the deceased are informed. The suspect is arrested and due to appear in the Okakarara Magistrate Court on Tuesday 02 October 2018. Police investigation continues.

Karasburg - Culpable Homicide on 30 September 2018 about 15:00 on the C12 gravel road +5km from Grunau on the Ai-ais road; Adam Davids 29 years old died on the spot after the driver (42) of the vehicle he was travelling in, lost control of the vehicle after a tyre burst. Two passengers (40 and 29 years old) sustained serious to slight injuries and were treated at Karasburg Hospital. The next of kin of the deceased is informed and police investigation continues.

Omuthiya – Suicide on 30 September 2018 at around 15:00 at Onakankuzi West village; Martha Haikali 59 years old was found by her granddaughter hanging from a wire under a hut in her homestead. A suicide note was found and police investigation continues.

Tsandi - Culpable homicide / Driving a motor vehicle without Driving licence on 30 September 2018 about 1521hrs on the Iitananga/Omakange main road at Omakango village; it is alleged that a unlicensed driver of a white Ford pickup was driving from Okahao to Amaupa village carrying five (05) passengers and overloaded bags of cement. The driver lost control over the motor vehicle and it overturn. One passenger Shipingana Timoteus (age unknown) died at the scene whilst other four (04) passengers sustained serious to slight injuries and are being treated at Tsandi and Oshakati State Hospitals, respectively. The next of kin of the deceased is informed. No arrest yet and Police investigation continues.

Ariamsvlei - Culpable Homicide on 30 September 2018 at about 16:30 on the Ariamsvlei/Karasburg B3 road +/- 27km from Ariamsvlei; a 77 years old driver

Gideon Oberholster , was travelling with his family from Upington to Karasburg via Ariamsvlei when he lost control over the vehicle and it overturned. The driver died on the scene whilst his passengers, 86 and 68 years old sustained slight to serious injuries. The next of kin have been informed. Police investigation continues.

Okahandja – Murder on 30 September 2018 about 23h00 at Sharko Bar, Donker location; Elrico Eiseb 26 years old succumbed to injuries at Okahandja State Hospital after he was stabbed in the chest with unknown sharp object by a 23 years old man. The next of kin is informed. The suspect arrested and Police investigation continues.

Keetmanshoop - Attempted Murder, on 30 September 2018 around 02:30 at Mimosa Street, Kronlein; A 44 years old woman was found laying unconscious and bleeding profusely with a cut wound on the head. She was rushed to the hospital where she is receiving medical attention. No one is arrested and police investigation continues. Anyone with information is requested to contact Chief Inspector Hanse on 081 230 3279.

Windhoek - Combating of Rape Act, Act 8/ 2000; a rape case was opened after a man (32) was allegedly raped by trial awaiting prisoners at Windhoek Police Station in the Trial Awaiting Cells. The act was allegedly committed upon an order by a City Police officer. The incident happened on 28 September 2018 during the afternoon hours where the suspects (trial awaiting prisoners) allegedly had sexual intercourse with the complainant under coercive circumstances. A police investigation into this matter is underway.
