SUBJECT: WEEKEND SERIOUS INCIDENTS REPORT: 07-09 FEBRUARY 2020

Omuthiya-Reckless and or negligent driving and Driving Vehicle without driver's license: on Sunday 09/02/20 at about 00:00 at Onakankuzi village, it is alleged that the victim, 27 years old Namibian male who was one of the passenger in a Toyota pickup, fell from the vehicle and sustained serious injuries. The victim was transported to Omuthiya State Hospital by the driver, whereby he was later transferred to Onandjokwe State Hospital for further treatment. The victim is reported to be in a stable condition and Police investigation continues.

Okongo-Murder: on Sunday, 09/02/2020 at about 18:00 at Omutwewomunhu Cuca shops, it is alleged that the deceased, 36 years old, Namibian male, a resident of Omutwewomunhu village, died on the spot after he was stabbed with a pocket knife in the right thigh and left leg. It is further alleged that an argument and a fight erupted amongst a group of boys who had knives and attacked the suspect. The suspect ran away but was chased by the deceased who picked up a dry stick which he assaulted the suspect with, and in the process the suspect stabbed the deceased with a knife he took from one of the boys and died on the spot. The victim's next of kin were. The suspect was arrested and Police investigation continues.

Omungwelume-Inquest (Drowning): on Sunday 09/02/2020 at around 17:40, at Omundudu village, Endola Constituency, it is alleged that the deceased, a 09 years old Namibian male minor drowned in the earth dam where he was swimming with other children. His next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.

Keetmanshoop-Murder and Attempted Murder: on 10/02/2020 at about 00:00, at Quiver tree lodge 10 km from Keetmanshoop, on the Keetmanshoop-Koes road, it is alleged that an unknown person was shot and killed by the lodge owner and wounded another unknown victim who was taken to the Keetmanshoop State Hospital for treatment, while a third person escaped. It is further alleged that the suspects were attempting to rob and steal properties but were caught in the act at shot at. Police investigation continues.

Omaruru-Stock Theft: between January 2020 and 06 February 2020 unknown time, at the grazing area at Farm Omenje no. 119, Omaruru area, it is alleged that the suspect/s stole nine (9) cattle at the value of N\$55000.00. No recovery and arrest were made and Police investigation continues.

Oshakati-Contravening Reg.34 read Section 1, 21 of Petroleum Product and Energy Act 13, 1990: on Friday 07.02.2020 at about 09:00, at Erf 5226, Evululuko location, Oshakati, it is alleged that containers of petrol and diesel to the value of N\$ 14 958.20 were discovered by members of the Namibian Police Reserve Force in a Brown 4x4 Hilux Raider vehicle. Containers of 2x 5L full petrol; 5x 20L full diesel containers, 2 x 250L full diesel containers, 2x 220L full diesel were seized, no arrests were made and Police investigation in this regard continues.

Tsumeb-Contravening Reg. 10 Government Gazette no. 4077/2008 r/w Sect. 94 of Local Authorities Act 23/1993: on Friday 07/02/20 at around 15:50, at Boy's Scout farm premises, it is alleged that the victim, a 2 years old Namibian male, minor who was with two other boys to attend scouts classes was attacked by a pit bull (dog) and sustained seriously injuries. It is further alleged that the dogs were in a cage and the yard was locked but the dog allegedly managed to storm out of the closed cage and attacked the boy. Upon arrival of the Police officers at the scene, they found the dog still on top of the victim and in the process put down the dog. Police investigation continues.

Keetmanshoop-Murder: on Friday 2020/02/07 at about 21:13, at Koppieslaagte,Tseiblaagte, it is alleged that the deceased, 41,years old Namibian male, died on the spot after he was stabbed on the left side of the chest with a bread knife by the suspect, a 33 years old Namibian male. It is further alleged that the suspect and the deceased who are believed to be friends were drinking Ginger beer, during the process the suspect confronted the deceased over his meat whereby a quarrel erupted between them and the deceased insulted the suspect who led him to pull out a bread knife and stabbed the victim. The deceased next of kin were informed, suspect was arrested and Police investigation continues.

Klein Whk-Housebreaking with intent to rob and Robbery with aggravating circumstances: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at about 03h30, at Erf 12 Omaruru Street, Eros: it is alleged that five (5) male suspects broke open the front door of the house and gained entrance, held a 62 year old pensioner and four (4) others at gunpoint. In the process, the suspects got way with 5x Asser laptops, 1xShotgun, 4 wallets, 3x Nikon cameras, 3x cell phones and 1x VLF, all with the total amount of +/- N\$310, 000.00. It is suspected that the suspects entered through the riverbed and exited in the same way. No recoveries and arrests were made but Police investigation continues.

Henties Bay- In possession of Mandrax tablets: on Friday 07/02/2020 about 21:00, at house no. 671, Kunene street, Omdel location, it is alleged that during a Police search, the suspect , a 24 years old Namibian male was arrested after he was found in possession of 10xMandrax tablets to the value of N\$1200,00. He is expected to appear today in Swakopmund Magistrate court and Police investigation continues.

Omuthiya-Unnatural death: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at about 06h30, at Onamishu No.1 village, Omuthiya, it is alleged that the deceased, a 90 years old Namibian male Pensioner, was found dead in her sleeping room by her daughter. The deceased body was transported to Omuthiya Police Mortuary for a post-mortem to be conducted to determine the real cause of death. Her next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues. .

Kahenge-Culpable homicide: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at around 01:20, at Siya Village on Rundukurenkuru main Road, it is alleged that the deceased, 29 years old Namibian male who was a pedestrian by that time was bumped by a white Toyota Quantum which was traveling from the West to the Eastern direction. It is further alleged that the victim was bumped while attempting to cross the

road and died on the spot. The deceased body was transported to Bunya Mortuary pending postmortem report and the next of kin were informed. Police investigation continues.

Etayi-Culpable homicide and driving a motor vehicle without a driving license: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at about 13:50, on the earth road at Oshalembe village, Etayi Constituency, it is alleged that the deceased, 05 years old Namibian female minor, died after she was run over by an unlicensed driver of a white Toyota pickup bakkie. It is further alleged that the victim was lying down under a tree when she was ran over, she sustained serious head injuries, was rushed to Oshikuku State Hospital and immediately referred to Oshakati State Hospital, where she later passed away. The suspect was arrested and expected to appear in court today, 10/02/2020. The victim's next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.

Onayena-Inquest: on Saturday 08.02.2020 at 13h00, at Onathing- Onayena area, it is alleged that the deceased, 22 years old Namibian male's decomposed body was discovered in a swamp after he has drowned. The victim's body was transported to Omuthiya mortuary for a postmortem to be conducted to determine the cause of death. His next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.

Onandjaba-Robbery with aggravate circumstances and Rape: on Friday 07/02/2020 at around 23h30, at Olupito village, Okalongo. It is alleged that the (3) three unknown suspects entered the victim's room and woke her up, and demanded pension grant money. It is further alleged that the suspects threatened the victim, 67 years old Namibian female pensioner with a knife managed to rob her cash value of N\$800.00. One of the suspects allegedly had sexual intercourse with the victim without her consent and then fled the scene. No arrest and recovery were made. Police investigation continues.

Wanaheda-Armed robbery: on Saturday 8/02/2020 at about 13h30, at 74, Ongava Street, Okuryangava, it is alleged that the victim, a Zimbabwean male was robbed of an N\$80, 000-00 by three (3) unknown male suspects. It is further alleged that the victim sold his Ford Ranger vehicle to a 39 years old Namibian male for an amount of N\$200,000-00, however the buyer electronically transferred N\$80,000-00 into the bank account of the victim and N\$120,000-00 was paid cash to the victim. After the transaction, the buyer had to transport the victim home, but in the meantime, when the victim reached his destination, he allegedly asked the suspect to stop so that he disembark, but suddenly, three (3) suspects armed with knives came out of a vehicle towards their car and grabbed the envelope which consisted of cash money amounting to N\$120,000-00 from the victim and during the process the victim who is the seller tried to fight off the envelop until it was torn and resulted into some notes to fell and he managed only to grab off an amount of N\$40,000-00 and the other amount of N\$80 000-00 fled with the robbers. No recovery and arrests were made only the vehicle which was impounded and Police investigation continues.

Ondangwa-Rape: on Friday 07/02/2020 between 20h00 - 22h00, at Oneshoko village-Oshitayi, it is alleged that the victim 20 years old Namibian female was raped by the 30 years old Namibian male suspect. It is further alleged that the suspect approached the victim in her room as she was going to sleep, forcefully blocked the door from closing, threatened to kill the victim if she screams and pushed her on her bed and had sexual intercourse with victim without her consent. The suspect who is also a tenant at the same flats as the victim was arrested and he is expected to appear in Ondangwa Magistrate Court Today 10/02/2020. Police investigation continues.

Aroab-In possession of Cannabis: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at about 21:20, on C 16 Aroab/Keetmanshoop gravel road, it is alleged that during a Police search the suspect, a 31 years old Namibian male, was arrested after he was found in possession of one (1) pack of pure cannabis with

an unknown value. He is expected to appear in the Keetmanshoop Magistrate Court today 10/02/2020 and Police investigation continues.

Okondjatu-Culpable Homicide: on Saturday 8/02/2020 between 02:00 and 03:00, at Okondjatu gravel road,C22, it is alleged that the victim, a 43 years old Namibian male died when the driver of a Toyota pickup vehicle he was driving in lost control over it, overturned, rolled five times and landed on its wheels. It is further alleged that there were five (5) passengers during the time of the accident, whereby four (4) of them were injured and were transported to Okakarara State Hospital for treatment. The deceased next of kin were informed and Police investigation continues.

Gobabis-Suicide: on Saturday 8/02/2020 about 19h00, at Tswana Block residential area Epako, Gobabis, it is alleged that the deceased, a 29 years old, Namibian male died after he had stabbed himself with a broken bottle. It is further alleged that the victim and his girlfriend had an argument whereby the deceased allegedly grabbed the girlfriend on her throat and threatened to beat her with a wooden dropper pole, however, the girlfriend managed to escape from the hands of the deceased and ran away. After that, the deceased purportedly walked to the waste-skip where he took empty bottles, broke the bottles into pieces and stabbed himself that led to severe bleeding. Thereafter, it is alleged that the deceased stood up however collapsed. The police was alerted and he was rushed to Gobabis state hospital where he died. No suicide note was found, no foul play was suspected and Police investigation continues.

Ohangwena-Suicide (drowning): at unknown date, time, at Oipapakane village, Ohangwena Constituency, it is alleged that the deceased, a Namibian male drowned himself intentionally in an earth water dam after he stabbed another Namibian male victim with a knife. After his disappearance, his footprints were followed and led people to the dam where his body was found. It is further alleged that the stabbed victim sustained a slight injury and is being treated at Engela hospital. The Police divers were summoned from Oshakati to assist in the retrieval of the body from the dam and Police investigation continues.

Onayena-Rape: on Saturday 08/02/2020 around 21h00, at Oshana location Othimbika village, it is alleged that the victim, a 20 years old Namibian male was raped by the suspect, age unknown, who is a teacher at the same school as the victim. It is further alleged that the suspect called the victim to his bar and bought him a beer and later called him into the sleeping room at the same bar, forced the victim to have sexual intercourse with him. No arrest was made and Police investigations continue.

Katutura-Dealing in Mandrax: on Saturday 08/02/2020 at about 18h00, at Eichab Street, Damara location, Katutura, it is alleged that during a Police search two suspects aged 17 and 20 years old Namibian male were found in possession of 52x full and 2xhalf Mandrax tablets valued at N\$6360-00. Both suspects were arrested and Police investigation continues.

Epukiro Inquest: on Sunday 09/02/2020 at about 17:30, at Epukiro Post 3, it is alleged that the deceased, age unknown, Namibian male adult died after he had collapsed. It is further alleged that the deceased went to nearby house in the same location and asked for a pot so that he can cook porridge. After he had finished cooking the porridge he started eating however while sitting on a chair he allegedly collapsed and died on the spot. An autopsy report is awaited to determine the cause of death and his next of kin were informed. Police investigation continues.

Maltahöhe-Rape: on Sunday 09/02/2020 between 16h30 and 18h00, at Vaalkamp blikiesdorp, it is alleged that two suspects aged 30 and 34 years old Namibian male raped a minor victim aged 15 years old Namibian female. It is further alleged that the suspects invited the victim to their house and had sexual intercourse with her. Both suspects were arrested and Police investigation continues.

Impalila-Inquest: between 07:00 and 09:00, at Kawulu village, Impalila area, it is alleged the deceased, 45 years old died after he was attacked by a crocodile. It is further alleged that people who were nearby tried to rescue the victim however on the way to Katima Mulilo State Hospital he succumbed to his injuries. Police investigation continues.

Otjiwarongo-Stock Theft: at Farm Rodenstein, it is alleged that footprints of three unknown suspects were traced at farm Rodenstein. It is further alleged that farm workers followed the shoeprints and heard cattle making noise like being suffocated; they called the Police and met the workers at Waterberg Plateau gate. The footprints were followed until the place where they were found busy skinning off one cow and managed to arrest one suspect. A chase after two suspects were pursued and they ran away, in the process four cattle was slaughtered and three others were still in the wire snares with their hind legs chopped off. One suspect 38 years old Namibian male was arrested and Police investigation continues.
