Wanaheda - Armed robbery: on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 02h00 at High Line Primary school, Greenwell Matongo informal Settlement, it is alleged that six unidentified males armed with a pistol, held two security officers (of Shilimela Security Company), at gunpoint, assaulted them and robbed them of the company shotgun, a cell phone, they further proceeded to break open the office doors. It is not known what was stolen at this stage. The security guards were taken to the hospital for treatment. Police investigations continue.

Ongenga - Culpable Homicide: on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 07h00 at Onakaolo village, along Omafo - Okalongo road, it is alleged that Vickson Mtuleni (12) was bumped by a vehicle while crossing the road and succumbed to his injuries on the way to Engela State Hospital. Next of kin were informed. Police investigations continue.

Karibib - Illegal hunting: on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 03h00 at Farm Albrechtshohe, it is alleged that four suspects entered the farm with dogs and spears and killed two Oryx. It is further alleged that the suspects were intercepted by the Police Reservists together with the K9 Anti-poaching Security members from Karibib while they were busy loading the carcasses in a motor vehicle belonging to one of the

suspects. Three of the suspects managed to run away but they are known, while one of them, the owner of the vehicle, drove off from the scene but was later arrested and his vehicle was impounded. The two Oryx carcasses valued N\$20 000-00 were recovered. Police investigations continue.

Onandjaba – Stock Theft: on Friday 06/03/2020 at around 15h00 at Okathitu Konkayi village in Omusati Region, it is alleged that the suspect stole and slaughtered one goat valued at N\$1 500-00. The carcass was recovered. The suspect fled the scene but he is known. Police investigations continue.

Arandis - Dealing in Cannabis and Mandrax: on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 21h20 two suspects; a 45 years old Namibian female and a 36 years old Namibian Male were arrested after they sold 16 full, three halves and five quarters of Mandrax tablets and 10 grams of Cannabis to an undercover Police Officer. The drugs are valued at N\$2 750-00. The suspects will appear at Swakopmund Magistrate Court on today 09/03/2020. Police investigations continue.

Okahandja - Armed Robbery: on Friday 06/03/2020 at around 22h45 in front of Okahandja Bar, Oshetu no.1, Nau-aib, it is alleged that the victim brought cash from another bar to where she was staying for safe-keeping, but was held at gunpoint, after embarking from the vehicle and robbed off N\$63 000 in cash, jackpot keys and her personal handbag. The victim alleged that three shots were fired in the air by one of the robbers. The suspect then fled on foot. No arrest or recovery made yet and police investigations continue.

Otjiwarongo – Murder: on Saturday 07/03/2020 at about 01h30, at Chezban bar, Orwetoveni, it is alleged that Lucky Petrus (23) was allegedly stabbed with an unknown object on the neck and was transported to Otjiwarongo State Hospital where he was pronounced dead upon arrival. The suspect is unknown at this stage and no arrest has been made. Police investigations continue.

Ondobe - Culpable Homicide, Reckless and/or negligent driving: on Saturday 07/03/2020 at about 09h20 at Eembidi village along Onhuno - Eenhana road, it is alleged that the driver of a white Toyota RunX was overtaking another vehicle and in the process collided head on with an oncoming vehicle, a white Mitsubishi Colt pick-up.

The driver of the RunX died on the spot, one of his passengers died at Engela hospital a few minutes after arrival while other two passengers sustained serious to moderate injuries. The driver of the Colt sustained serious injuries. Deceased: Tomas Tukondjeni Nghoshi (34) and Lydia Makili (53). Their next of kin were informed. The injured were rushed to Engela State Hospital. Police investigations continue.

Kuisebmond - Inquest (Suicide): on Saturday 07/03/2020 at about 10h40 Uugwanga Street, Kuisebmond location, it is alleged that the lifeless body of Abraham Uuwanga (47) was discovered hanging from the roof, in the garage with a rope around his neck. It is alleged that the deceased was last seen on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 14h00. No Suicide note found. Next of kin were informed and police investigations continue.

Omahenene – Inquest (Drowning): on Saturday 07/03/2020 at around 09h40 at Omagolowani village in Omusati Region, it is alleged that the lifeless body of a 25 years old Angolan Male, was discovered, in a decomposing state, in a water canal, by an employee of Namwater. The deceased was allegedly last seen on Thursday 05/03/2020 when he went out to the cuca shops but never returned. His next of kin were informed. Police investigations continue.

Okahao - Attempted Murder: on Friday 06/03/2020 at about 19h00 at Oshaanda, Eendombe village in Omusati Region, it is alleged that a 20 years old Namibian male, 20 sustained serious injury after he was stabbed with a knife once in the stomach. He is admitted at Oshakati Intermediate Hospital in critical condition. A 22 years old male (suspect) was arrested and he will appear at Okahao Magistrate court today 09/03/2020. Police investigations continue.

Ondobe - Inquest (Drowning): on Saturday 07/03/2020 at about 19h00 at Eembidi village, it is alleged that Sirkka Naveuye Hamunyela (3) drowned in a water pond. It is further alleged that the deceased and another child were fetching water from a water pond situated nearby their house and during the process of fetching water her container fell into the pond and she made an attempt to retrieve it resulting in her falling into the pond. Next of kin were informed and police investigations continue.

Nkurenkuru – Rape: on 08/03/2020 and at about 01h30 in Nkurenkuru town, it is alleged that a 26 years old female, a student at IUM Campus, Nkurenkuru, was raped

by an unknown male, while on her way home from town. No arrest made yet and police investigations continue.

Okahandja - Culpable homicide: on Sunday 08/03/2020 at about 12h00, an accident happened on the Okahandja - Hochfeld road, about 40km from Okahandja, whereby a white Toyota pickup collided into a truck from behind and overturned killing two people; Julius Sheende (46) and Erenfriede Mujaru (40). Three other passengers were injured and were transported to Okahandja State Hospital. The truck driver escaped unharmed. Next of kin were informed and police investigations continue.

Rehoboth - Possession of cannabis: on Saturday 07/03/2020 at around 22h00 at Block E Rehoboth, four males aged 27, 32, 44 and 59 were arrested after they were found in possession of 90 grams of cannabis valued at N\$4 500-00 after a police search. Police investigations continue.

Stampriet - Culpable homicide: on Sunday 08/03/2020 at about 18h00 along Stampriet - Aranos road, it is alleged that the driver of a white corolla sedan lost control of the vehicle and it overturned killing one passenger; Marko Snyman (10). The driver (a 24 years old female) sustained back injuries. Police investigations continue.

Onayena – Inquest (Suicide): on Sunday 08/03/2020 around 18h30 at Iikokola village in Oshikoto Region, it is alleged that the lifeless body of a 22 year old Angolan male, was found lying under a tree with an electrical cable around his neck. No suicide note was found. Next of kin are not yet informed. Police investigations continue.

Ondangwa – Inquest (Suicide): on Sunday 08/03/2020 it is alleged that the lifeless body of Joseph Japhet (57) was discovered in a hut with a rope around his neck. No suicide note found. Next of kin were informed. Police investigations continue.

Oshakati – Contravention of Section 21 of Petroleum Act: on Saturday 07/03/2020 at about 10h30 at Okangwena location, it is alleged that a female suspect ran away after she was found selling fuel. Forty-three containers of petrol valued at N\$14 496-30 were seized and a Toyota Hilux which was used in the commission of the offence was impounded. Police investigations continue.

Omungwelume - Rape: on Sunday 08/03/2020 between 00h00 and 02h00 at Onanhadi village, it is alleged that a 20 years old male raped his nine year old cousin while she was sleeping. The suspect and the victim reside in the same house. The suspect was arrested. Police investigations continue.

Rundu - Culpable homicide: on Sunday 8/03/2020 at about 20h00 at Tyeye village, it is alleged that Kadir Matheus (age unknown) was bumped by a bus while crossing the road and died on the spot. Next of kin were informed. Police investigations continue.
